NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

The subject matter of the January 3 open meeting will be:

Consideration of whether to adopt Form N-SAR, a new semi-annual reporting form for registered investment companies, withdrawal of Forms N-1R, N-5R, N-30A-2, N-30A-3 and 2-MD, the annual reporting forms now used by most registered investment companies, and a temporary suspension of the quarterly filing obligations of investment companies. Consideration will also be given to whether to propose for public comment amendments to Forms N-1A and N-2 that would conform the method required to calculate a registrant's portfolio turnover rate in those registration statements to the method required by Form N-SAR. RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

ADOPTION OF FINAL RULE AMENDMENTS GOVERNING DESIGNATION OF NATIONAL MARKET SYSTEM SECURITIES

In response to a petition from the NASD, the Commission is adopting amendments to its rule governing the designation of securities qualified for trading in a national market system. These amendments substantially increase the number of securities that are eligible for designation as National Market System Securities. (Rel. 34-21583)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES PETROLEUM ACREAGE CORPORATION OF TEXAS; SOVEREIGN CHEMICAL & PETROLEUM PRODUCTS, INC.

The Commission filed civil injunctive actions on December 14 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Petroleum Acreage Corporation of Texas, of San Antonio, Texas, and Sovereign Chemical & Petroleum Products, Inc., of Chicago, Illinois. The complaints allege violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws and seek judgments of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief.

The Commission alleges that Petroleum and Sovereign, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file: their Annual Reports on Form 10-K for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1984, required to have been filed by September 28, 1984; their Quarterly Reports on Form 10-Q for the fiscal quarter ending September 30, 1984, required to have been filed by November 14, 1984; various periodic reports on time; and Notifications of Late Filing on Form 12b-25 respecting the periodic reports which Petroleum and Sovereign filed late. The Commission requests that the Court order Petroleum and Sovereign to file their delinquent annual and quarterly reports and enjoin them from further violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

PEGGY D. STINES RECEIVES 99-YEAR SENTENCE

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on December 14 U.S. District Judge Jerry Buchmeyer sentenced Peggy D. Stines of Garland, Texas to consecutive terms totalling 99 years imprisonment based upon her conviction of 20 counts of wire fraud. After Stines discharges the 99-year sentence, Judge Buchmeyer ordered her placed on 30 years probation for the three remaining counts of the 23-count indictment on which she was convicted on November 13. In addition, Judge Buchmeyer levied fines upon Stines totalling \$80,000, and ordered her to pay over \$600,000 in restitution to the 23 victims named in the indictment. The August 8 indictment was the result of a grand jury investigation into Stines' activities in the sale of investment contracts for the purpose of processing photographic film for its silver content. With the aid of her husband, Donald R. Stines, it was alleged that from June 1981 until July 1984 Stines engaged in a "Ponzi scheme" in which she raised over \$17 million from over 1,000 investors. Donald R. Stines is scheduled to be tried on similar charges on January 7, 1985. (U.S. v. Peggy D. Stines, et al., USDC NDTX, CR-3-84-203R). (LR-10640)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Inc. The proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-84-29) provides that closing rotations in expiring series of individual stock options on the last trading day prior to expiration cannot begin until the final price of the underlying stock is established in its primary market. NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-84-33) to amend Article III, Section 19 of the NASD Rules of Fair Practice to provide, as part of the NASD rules, that NASD members must comply with Rule 15c3-3 respecting the rule's requirements regarding possession and control of securities and the maintenance of cash reserves by a broker-dealer. The proposal also includes certain related amendments. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of December 24. (Rel. 34-21598)
