Thursday, February 8

The Securities Subcommittee of the Senate Banking Committee will hold a hearing on issues relating to small investors on Thursday, February 8, in Room 538 of the Dirksen Senate Office Building, beginning at 9:30 a.m. Joseph Goldstein, Associate Director, Division of Enforcement, and Richard G. Ketchum, Director, Division of Market Regulation, will testify on penny stock fraud and the arbitration process.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES WILLIAM E. ROONEY, SR.

The Chicago Regional Office filed a Complaint on January 2 in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois against William E. Rooney, Sr. The Complaint seeks to enjoin Rooney from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws, and to obtain an accounting and disgorgement of ill-gotten proceeds.

The Complaint alleges that, between 1972 and 1989, Rooney violated the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws in connection with his offer and sale of nine-month promissory notes issued by three companies he controlled. Specifically, the Complaint alleges that Rooney misrepresented that the proceeds from the sales of the notes would be applied to finance the consumer loan businesses of said companies. However, contrary to his representations, Rooney was conducting a Ponzi scheme as well as diverting proceeds from the notes to his other businesses and to his personal account. Rooney raised approximately \$12 million from the sales of the notes, which have accrued \$16 million of interest. (SEC v. William E. Rooney Sr., ND IL, E. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NORTHEAST UTILITIES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 26 to file comments or request a hearing on a proposal by Northeast Utilities and its service subsidiary, Northeast Utilities Service Company (NUSCO), to acquire Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH), a New Hampshire corporation, under A Joint Plan of Reorganization. PSNH currently is a debtor-in-possession in bankruptcy reorganization proceedings under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code, pending in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court, District of New Hampshire.

The Plan proposes, among other things, that: (1) Northeast acquire all of PSNH's common stock; (2) PSNH transfer its 35.6% ownership interest in the Seabrook Nuclear Power Project (Seabrook) to the to-be-formed North Atlantic Energy Corporation (North Atlantic), a company that will be a wholly-owned subsidiary of Northeast; (3) the formation of Northeast Utilities Operating Company (NUOP) as a wholly owned subsidiary of Northeast that will assume responsibility for the operation of Seabrook; (4) the issuance by Northeast, PSNH and North Atlantic of certain securities in connection with the Plan; and (5) certain related transactions.
