RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

RULE AMENDMENT

The Commission is amending its rules pertaining to public observance of Commission meetings to include a notice to handicapped persons of the procedures necessary to obtain auxiliary aids, such as sign language interpreters. (Rel. 33-6856)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

SUZANNE VUKO PERMANENTLY ENJOINED; JOHN VUKO ENJOINED

The Commission filed a Complaint on March 13 in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of California against Suzanne and John Vuko, alleging that they purchased Convergent, Inc. common stock while in possession of material, non-public information concerning the possible merger of Convergent and Unisys Corp. Without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint, Suzanne Vuko consented to the entry of a Final Judgment permanently enjoining and restraining her from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act, ordering disgorgement of \$11,145.35, and requiring payment of a \$24,975 penalty under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act. John Vuko, without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint, consented to the entry of a Final Order enjoining and restraining him from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act. [SEC v. Suzanne Vuko and John Vuko, USDC NDC, Civil Action No. 90-0750 (DLJ)] (LR-12408)

GENE KASLOW ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on March 9 the Honorable Charles Haight enjoined Gene Kazlow, New York attorney, from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. Kazlow consented to the entry of the order without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint. The Complaint alleged that Kazlow acted as the attorney for two "blind pool" securities offerings, Green Mountain Venture Corporation and Monvert Financial Corporation. The registration statement described the disclosed officers and directors as control persons who provided the issuer with its initial capitalization. The Complaint alleged that, in fact, Kazlow solicited three friends to become the officers and directors of Green Mountain and three others to do the same for Monvert, all with the understanding that they would have little or no active role in the companies. Kazlow and other undisclosed control persons controlled the issuers and provided the funds used for the initial capitalization of the companies. [SEC v. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ACM PORTUGAL FUND CHINA FUND

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until April 11 to request a hearing on applications filed by: ACM PORTUGAL FUND, INC. and THE CHINA FUND, INC. for orders under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act, declaring that they have ceased to be investment companies. FREEDOM INVESTMENT TRUST

An order has been issued on an application filed by Freedom Investment Trust, Freedom Investment Trust II and Freedom Investment Trust III amending prior orders to permit additional waivers of a contingent deferred sales load. (Rel. IC-17373 - Mar. 12)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-90-06) to reorganize and renumber the Exchange Rules of the Board of Governors has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act. (Rel. 34-27787)

PARTIAL ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has noticed a rule change submitted by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-89-30) that proposes that the rules governing market maker eligibility for Retail Automatic Execution System (RAES) in Standard & Poor's 500 Index options (SPX) be approved on a permanent basis. The Commission also approved, on an accelerated basis, the portion of the rule change that extends the CBOE's pilot program governing market maker standards for RAES in SPX options. (Rel. 34-27790)
