## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

### WELLSHIRE SECURITIES, OTHERS SUBJECT TO RESTRAINING ORDER

The New York Regional Office announced that, on March 14, U.S. District Court Judge Kevin Duffy, Southern District of New York, issued a Temporary Restraining Order, an Asset Freeze and Other Equitable Relief against Wellshire Securities, Inc.; Robert Cohen, Wellshire's President; Carol Martino, Wellshire's Executive Vice President; and Joseph Jenkins, Jr., a Wellshire broker.

The Commission's Complaint alleges that, from June 1988 to the present, Wellshire, under the direction and supervision of Cohen and Martino, has operated as a "boiler room" selling speculative securities to the public. The Complaint alleges that Wellshire's brokers, including Jenkins, used violative sales practices in selling securities to the investing public.

The Commission Complaint alleges that Edward Braverman and Alan Diamond, two former Wellshire employees, participated in Wellshire's violative conduct. The Commission's Complaint also alleges that Ventura Inc., a publicly traded leasing company, and two of its principals, Robert Beck and Richard Sands, and Environmental Landfills, a publicly traded company that owns a closed landfill, and its Chairman, Paul Winters, Jr., supplied false and misleading information to Wellshire which ultimately reached the public. The Commission's Complaint alleges that all the defendants violated the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws and seeks disgorgement from them. [SEC v. Wellshire Securities, Inc., et al. 90 Civ. 1707 (USDC SDNY)] (LR-12411)

### SHIRLEY A. AND GEORGE S. SHIFFMAN PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Honorable John M. Manos, U.S. District Judge for the Northern District of Ohio, on March 14, permanently enjoined Shirley A. Shiffman and George S. Shiffman of Cleveland, Ohio, from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act in connection with George Shiffman's purchase and sale of securities of Revco D.S., Inc., Magnetics International, Inc. and Fisher Foods, Inc. The complaint alleged that Shirley Shiffman, an employee of Golenberg & Co., an investment banking company, misappropriated information by informing her husband of material nonpublic events concerning the above companies.

The Shiffmans, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint, consented to the entry of Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction. George Shiffman was ordered to disgorge \$52,839 plus \$18,415 in prejudgment interest and to pay a penalty of \$52,839. After the Complaint was filed, George Shiffman filed for bank-

ruptcy. The Commission is pursuing its claims for disgorgement and prejudgment interest in the bankruptcy proceedings. The Court waived collection of the civil penalty based upon George Shiffman's bankruptcy filing. [SEC v. Shirley A. Shiffman and George S. 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### INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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L.F. ROTHSCHILD EARNINGS AND LIQUIDITY  
L.F. ROTHSCHILD EXEMPT FUND

Orders have been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that L.F. ROTHSCHILD EARNINGS AND LIQUIDITY, INC. and L.F. ROTHSCHILD EXEMPT FUND, INC. have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-17375 and IC-17376, respectively - Mar. 13)

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### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing National Fuel Gas Company to repurchase up to \$50 million of its outstanding shares of common stock (no par) from time to time during a two-year period beginning March 9. (Rel. 35-25052)

SAVANNAH ELECTRIC AND POWER COMPANY  
PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF OKLAHOMA

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until April 2 to request a hearing on proposals by: SAVANNAH ELECTRIC AND POWER COMPANY, electric public utility subsidiary of The Southern Company, to redeem, retire or otherwise acquire up to: (1) \$96 million of its first mortgage bonds; (2) \$20 million of preferred stock; and (3) \$20 million of pollution or industrial development revenue bonds. Savannah further proposes to redeem in whole three series of its outstanding \$100 par preferred stock; and PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF OKLAHOMA (PSO), wholly owned electric public utility subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, to lease to nonaffiliate companies, from time to time through September 30, 1994, unit trains and railcars owned by PSO.
