ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDING INSTITUTED AGAINST MI-5 AND LAWRENCE MURRAY

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under Sections 203(e) and (f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 against Management Intelligence Five Corp., (MI-5), a registered investment adviser located in West Chester, Pennsylvania, and Lawrence Murray, founder, shareholder and chairman of the board of MI-5.

The Order alleges as grounds for action against MI-5 and Murray violations of the antifraud and registration provisions of MI-5, Venture Frontiers Corp., (Venture) and Financial Management Professional Corp., (FMPC), prior to their becoming associated with MI-5. Murray is chairman of the board of Venture and FMPC. The Order alleges that Murray and Venture made false statements in press releases which misrepresented the conditional nature and expected profitability of two overseas ventures in which Venture held an interest. The Order further alleges that FMPC and Murray engaged in fraudulent offerings of unregistered limited partnership interests. On June 27, 1989, the Commission filed an injunctive action against Murray, Venture, and FMPC based upon similar allegations. The Administrative Proceedings are also based on Murray's conviction in December 1989 for multiple counts of tax fraud. (Rel. IA-1237)
