## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### COMPLAINT NAMES GOLDBERG & ASSOCIATES FINANCIAL ADVISORS, STEVEN GOLDBERG

The Philadelphia Regional Office announced that, on July 18, the Commission filed a Complaint in the U.S. District Court for the District of Maryland against Goldberg & Associates Financial Advisors, Inc. (Goldberg & Associates) and Steven Barry Goldberg. Goldberg is president and sole owner of Goldberg & Associates, an investment adviser registered with the Commission. The Complaint seeks a permanent injunction against future violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act, the Securities Exchange Act and the Investment Advisers Act, an accounting and disgorgement.

The Complaint alleges that from 1984 to 1989, Goldberg & Associates and Goldberg engaged in a scheme to defraud investors by raising approximately \$875,000 from advisory clients through the fraudulent sale of securities in the form of promissory notes and investment contracts in real estate, commodities and a start-up company. To induce individuals to invest, the Complaint alleges that Goldberg made material misrepresentations and omitted to state material facts concerning the nature of the investments, the degree of risk, the rate of return, and the use of proceeds. In addition, the Commission alleges that Goldberg misappropriated \$185,000 from an advisory client who had given Goldberg these funds for the purchase of gold bars. [SEC v. ### JUDGMENT AGAINST R.G. REYNOLDS ENTERPRISES, INC., RICHARD REYNOLDS

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that, on July 18, it filed a Motion for Judgment of Civil Contempt Against Defendants R.G. Reynolds Enterprises, Inc. (Enterprises) and Richard "R.G." Reynolds (Reynolds) based on their failure to comply

with the Court's Partial Summary Judgment, entered on December 13, 1989, and the Court's Stipulation and Judgment and Order re Payment of Disgorgement (Order), entered on February 2, 1990. The Partial Summary Judgment and Order provide that Enterprises and Reynolds are to disgorge \$5,708,252.00 to the Disbursing Agent appointed by the Court. The disgorgement amount includes \$3,132,093.00 from the defendants' offer and sale of the Loan Program/Managed Account and \$823,075.00 from their offer and sale of the Moreland Gold Program, both unregistered securities offerings, together with prejudgment interest.

The Commission's Motion states that, to date, Enterprises and Reynolds have failed to pay any part of the disgorgement and have not provided the Commission with any evidence demonstrating their inability to pay. The Motion requests that the Court find Enterprises and Reynolds in contempt of the Partial Summary Judgment and the Order and incarcerate Reynolds and/or assess a daily fine against the defendants until they pay the disgorgement. The Motion is scheduled to be heard on September 24, 1990. [SEC v. R.G. Reynolds Enterprises, Inc., et al., CDCA Civil Action No. 88-01978 AAH (Kx)] (LR-12554)

#### COMPLAINT NAMES ARKANSAS COMPANY, PRINCIPALS

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that, on July 18, a complaint seeking a Temporary Restraining Order and Other Equitable Relief was filed against Union National Mortgage Co. ("UNMC"), Mark Brandon Hopkins (Hopkins), and Timothy Bryan Gibbons (Gibbons), all of Little Rock, Arkansas, in the U.S. District Court, Eastern Division of Arkansas, in Little Rock, Arkansas.

The complaint charges that defendants UNMC, Hopkins, and Gibbons conducted a "free-riding" scheme, in which they persuaded at least six regional broker-dealers to open accounts for UNMC and to purchase or sell millions of dollars of government securities for UNMC. It is further alleged that the defendants failed to pay for government securities bought and sold by UNMC causing various broker-dealers to lose at least \$182,000, and resulting in a profit to them of over \$62,000. The complaint seeks a freeze of the defendants' assets, temporary and permanent injunctions, and disgorgement of illegally obtained profits with prejudgment interest on such profits. [SEC v.
