FOIA ANNOUNCEMENTS

FOIA APPEAL OF HILL'S CAPITOL SECURITY, INC.

The General Counsel sent a letter to Mitchell Paul, General Counsel of Hill's Capitol Security, Inc., affirming in part, reversing in part, and remanding in part the Freedom of Information Act Officer's decision to deny access to specified documents related to the Commission's solicitation of proposals, and subsequent contract award, for security services at the Judiciary Plaza Commission headquarters building. The FOIA Officer denied access to the requested documents on the basis of FOIA Exemptions 4 and 5, 5 USC 552(b)(4) and (5), 17 CFR 200.80(b)(4) and (5). The General Counsel determined to release in its entirety one document that does not appear to be protected by any FOIA exemptions; release certain documents with portions redacted under FOIA Exemption 5; and remand certain documents to the FOIA Officer for his review. The documents remanded to the FOIA Officer contain information that may be protected under FOIA Exemption 4 and that is identical to information in documents which are the subject of pending confidential treatment requests. These documents also contain information that may be protected under FOIA Exemption 5. (Rel. FOIA-103)

FOIA APPEAL OF THE BOARD OF TRADE OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO

The General Counsel sent a letter to Mark D. Young, Kirkland & Ellis, counsel for the Board of Trade of the City of Chicago (CBOT), reversing the FOIA Officer's decision to deny access to the request for a no-action or interpretive position submitted on behalf of RMJ Securities Corp. and RMJ Options Trading Corp. regarding the status of a proposed system for computerized trading of options on U.S. Government securities. The General Counsel determined that FOIA Exemption 3, 5 USC 552(b)(3), 17 CFR 200.80(b)(3), should not be applied to withhold the responsive documents. (Rel. FOIA-104)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST LEONARD S. BERMAN

The Commission approved the institution of administrative proceedings under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Leonard S. Berman of Old Bridge, New Jersey.

The Order for Proceedings alleges that on December 16, 1986, in the District of New Jersey, Berman pled guilty to an Information charging him with Obstruction of Proceedings Before an Agency in violation of 18 USC §1505. Berman's guilty plea directly related to his attempt to induce a witness to give false testimony before the Commission. Specifically, Berman instructed the witness to testify falsely that a securities trading account in the witness' name was not in fact a nominee account for Berman. On March 17, 1987, a judgment of conviction was entered against Berman, and he was sentenced to a five-year period of incarceration. That sentence was suspended, and Berman was resentedenced to three years probation.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against Berman are true and, if so, to determine what, if any, remedial action would be appropriate. (Rel. 34-26467)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER ISSUED AGAINST VINCENT JOHN MILITANO AND MILTON SONNEBERG

The New York Regional Office announced that on January 25 Judge John F. Keenan, Southern District of New York, issued a temporary restraining order against Vincent John Militano and Milton Sonneberg, two registered representatives with Moore & Schley, Cameron & Co., restraining them from further violations of the securities laws and freezing their assets except for the payment of ordinary living expenses and attorneys fees. In a Complaint filed on January 25, the Commission charged defendants with violating Sections 9(a), 10(b), and 13(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5, 13d-1, and 13d-2, and sought a permanent injunction enjoining them from further violations of the securities laws as well as disgorgement of all commissions and profits from unlawful transactions. The Commission also sought a preliminary injunction. Militano and Sonneberg are charged with cornering the market and manipulating the price of the common stock of Chase Medical Group Inc. Judge Keenan ordered a hearing on the preliminary injunction on February 23. (SEC v. John Militano and Milton Sonneberg, Civil Action No. 89-0572, JFK). (LR-11973)

APPOINTMENT OF ESCROW AND DISTRIBUTION AGENT

The Commission announced that on January 11 U.S. District Judge John F. Keenan, Southern District of New York, ordered the appointment of Richard H. Walker as Escrow and Distribution Agent in accordance with the Commission's Plan for the Disposition of Disgorgement Funds and Appointment of Escrow and Distribution Agent in SEC v. Armand Leone Sr. and Rita F. Leone, 88 Civ. 2818 (SDNY, April 21, 1988).

The Commission filed a Complaint on April 21, 1988 alleging that both defendants violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 in connection with the purchases of First Jersey National Corporation securities. Simultaneously, defendants, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief, to disgorge \$774,302, and to pay a one time penalty of \$480,916 under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1984. (SEC v. Armand Leone Sr. and Rita F. Leone, 88 Civ. 2818, RJD). (LR-11977)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SCUDDER CALIFORNIA TAX FREE FUND

An order has been issued exempting Scudder California Tax Free Fund, et al., from the provisions of Section 32(a)(1) of the Investment Company Act to permit them to file financial statements signed or certified by an independent public accountant selected at a Board of Directors/Trustees meeting held within 90 days before or after the beginning of such Applicant's fiscal year. (Rel. IC-16770 - Jan. 23)

PRUDENTIAL MUTUAL FUND MANAGEMENT, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 16 to request a hearing on an application filed by Prudential Mutual Fund Management, Inc. (PMF), Prudential Mutual Fund Distributors, Inc. (PMFD), and Prudential-Bache Securities, Inc., on behalf of the Prudential-Bache Mutual Funds, for an order amending a prior order. The prior order exempted Prudential-Bache from the provisions of Section 22(d) of the Investment Company Act to permit a waiver of a contingent deferred sales load. The requested order would extend the exemptive relief granted by the prior order to PMF and PMFD. (Rel. IC-16771 - Jan. 23)

CIGNA FUNDS GROUP

An order has been issued exempting Cigna Funds Group, et al., from the provisions of Section 32(a)(1) of the Investment Company Act to permit them to file financial statements signed or certified by an independent public accountant selected at a Board of Directors or Trustees meeting held within 90 days after the end of such Applicant's fiscal year. (Rel. IC-16772 - Jan. 23)

RICHARD ALAN DANIELS

An order has been issued granting Richard Alan Daniels a limited exemption from the provisions of Section 9(a) of the Investment Company Act applicable to him by virtue of an injunction entered in SEC v. Price, Allen & Stevens Incorporated, and a criminal conviction in U.S. v. Daniels. (Rel. IC-16773 - Jan. 24)

STING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

WITHDRAWAL SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 10 to comment on the application of DAMSON OIL CORPORATION to withdraw its Class A common stock, \$.01 par value, \$3.00 cumulative convertible preferred stock, \$1.00 par value, and \$2.50 cumulative convertible preferred stock, \$1.00 par value, from listing and registration on the American Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-26479)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change has been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-88-29) and The American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-88-29) to amend their arbitration procedures to conform with recently approved amendments to the Uniform Code of Arbitration as adopted by the Securities Industry Conference on Arbitration. (Rel. 34-26474; 34-26475)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of January 30.

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval for 90 days to a proposed rule change filed by The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (SR-NASD-89-4) that adds a limit order storage and execution capability to its Small Order Execution System. (Rel. 34-26476)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-88-37) to increase the unit of trading of the French franc foreign currency options from 125,000 francs to 250,000 francs and to modify the minimum fractional change for dealing on the Exchange in French franc option contracts from \$.00005 to \$.00002. (Rel. 34-26478)

ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.

Below is a list of recent filings of Schedules 13D and 14D, which includes the following information: Column 1 - the company purchased (top), and the name of the purchaser; Column 2 - the type of security purchased; Column 3 - the type of form filed; Column 4 - the date the transaction occurred; Column 5 - the current number of shares (in 000's) owned (top) and the current percent owned; Column 6 - the CUSIP number (top) and the prior percent owned; and Column 7 - the status of the filing, i.e., new, update or revision.
