CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST ARTHUR P. MILLER

The Chicago Regional Office filed a Complaint on January 17 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Ohio seeking a Permanent Injunction against Arthur P. Miller. The Complaint alleges that Miller violated the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Specifically, the Complaint alleges that Miller offered and sold unregistered securities in the form of interests in a mortgage account. Miller raised approximately \$4.3 million from at least 125 investors, and made and caused to be made to the investors material misrepresentations and omissions. The Complaint also seeks disgorgement from Miller. (SEC v. Arthur P. Miller, USDC SDOH, Civil Action No. C2-89-44). (LR-11976)
