RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

AMENDMENTS ADOPTED

The Commission adopted amendments to its rules to reduce the time period from 15 calendar days to five business days for a registrant to file a Form 8-K announcing a change in its independent certifying accountant or a resignation of a director because of a disagreement between the director and management on any matter relating to the registrant's operations, policies, or practices.

The Commission also adopted amendments to Regulation S-K concerning changes in a registrant's independent certifying accountant to (1) reduce the time period for filing with the Commission the former accountant's letter stating its agreement with or objections to the registrant's disclosure, from 30 calendar days to ten business days after the filing of the report or registration statement disclosing the change in accountants; (2) require the registrant to file any such letter within two business days of receipt; and (3) and permit the former accountant to provide an interim letter to the registrant, which also must be filed by the registrant within two business days of receipt. The amendments are effective for changes in accountants and the receipt of letters from resigned directors occurring 30 days after publication of the amendments in the Federal Register. COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

CHANGE IN WEEKLY CALENDAR

Tomorrow's hearing on SEC appropriations has been changed from 10:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. The hearing is still scheduled to be held in Room H-309 of the Capitol Building.

TRADING SUSPENSIONS

TRADING SUSPENDED IN THE SECURITIES OF USA MEDICAL CORP.

The Commission announced the single ten-day suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of USA Medical Corp. for the period beginning at 9:30 a.m. (EST) on March 6 and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EST) on March 15.

The Commission suspended trading in the securities of USA Medical in view of questions that have been raised about recent market activity in USA Medical and about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things, the financial condition of the company, the identities of its shareholders, and the beneficial ownership of the company's shares. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CALIFORNIA DEFENSE CONTRACTOR AND ITS PRESIDENT ENJOINED

The Seattle Regional Office filed a Complaint for Injunction on February 15 in the Eastern District of California against Wilderness Electronics, Inc., a Sacramento, California defense contractor, and its president, Raymond A. Whitehead. The Complaint alleges violations of Sections 17(a)(1) and 17(a)(3) of the Securities Act of 1933 based on nondisclosures of the status of Wilderness' government contracts and repayment obligations in amendments to a Form S-18 registration statement of Pioneer Venture Corporation whereby Wilderness and Pioneer would merge.

A Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction was entered by Judge Edward J. Garcia against both defendants by consent on February 27. (SEC v. Wilderness Electronics, Inc., et al., EDCA, C89-0208 EJM-JFM). (LR-12018)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

PROMOTER SENTENCED IN OFFSHORE BANK FRAUD CASE

The Seattle Regional Office announced that on February 9 Ronald G. Vogeltanz was sentenced to concurrent five year probations and 200 hours of community service for each two counts of the sale of unregistered securities. Vogeltanz had pled guilty on November 21, 1988 to a criminal information charging him with the sale of unregistered common stock of a "brassplate" (name on door only) offshore (Mariana Islands) bank to 400 investors from 1983 through early 1985. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PACIFIC AMERICAN INCOME SHARES, INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Pacific American Income Shares, Inc. (Fund) and its investment adviser, Western Asset Management Company, exempting them from Section 15(a) of the Investment Company Act to permit the Fund to reimburse the adviser for costs incurred under an interim advisory contract entered into without prior shareholder approval. (Rel. IC-16843 - Mar. 1)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Consolidated Natural Gas Company, a registered holding company, to issue and sell through February 28, 1991 the remaining \$100 million of its debentures to be sold pursuant to a prior Commission order dated February 26, 1987 [Rel. 35-24326], less any amounts issued and sold prior to February 26, 1989. Jurisdiction has been reserved over the fees, expenses, terms, and conditions associated with any debentures that are priced on a noncompetitive basis. (Rel. 35-24828 - Mar. 1)

GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing General Public Utilities Corporation (GPU), a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Jersey Central Power & Light Company, Metropolitan Edison Company, and Pennsylvania Electric Company, to issue, sell, and renew their short-term notes and/or commercial paper, from time to time through March 31, 1992, in outstanding amounts not to exceed charter limitations in the case of the subsidiaries, and \$200 million in the case of GPU. Jurisdiction has been reserved regarding portions of the proposal. (Rel. 35-24829 - Mar. 1)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change has been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-88-51) to change the composition of arbitration panels and to establish what must be included in arbitration wards. (Rel. 34-26584); and The National Securities Clearing Corporation (SR-NSCC-89-2) to adopt rules and procedures that would accelerate the comparison of transactions executed over-the-counter and on exchanges other than the New York Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-26585)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of February 27.
