The Securities and Exchange Commission announced today the issues and participants for the Roundtable on proposed Rule 144A scheduled to be held on Wednesday, March 15, from 9:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. (Press Release 89-18)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

MILTON R. BLOOMQUIST SENTENCED

The Denver Regional Office, the Salt Lake City Branch Office, and the Acting U.S. Attorney for the District of Utah announced that on February 15 U.S. District Court Judge J. Thomas Greene sentenced Milton R. Bloomquist of Layton, Utah to six months' incarceration and five years' probation as a result of Bloomquist's having entered a plea of guilty to a two-count felony information. The information charged Bloomquist with two counts of willfully violating the securities registration requirements.

According to court documents, Bloomquist obtained some \$3.6 million from more than 100 investors from 1981 through 1987 on the basis of various omissions and misrepresentations. Bloomquist promised interest of from 24% to 36% from trading profits which he claimed to be making, and he issued securities in the form of demand promissory notes which he failed to register.

Earlier, Bloomquist was permanently enjoined from violating the securities registration, investment company registration, and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Bloomquist was also ordered to disgorge some \$2.5 million that he failed to repay investors, but payment of the disgorgement was waived based upon his demonstrated inability to pay it. (U.S. v. Milton R. Bloomquist, USDC DUT, Northern Division, Criminal Action No. 88-NCR-0056G). (LR-12026)

EDWARD M. KRIVDA SENTENCED

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on February 27 the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California sentenced Edward M. Krivda to 60 days in a halfway house and ordered him to perform 300 hours of community service for making false statements to the Commission during investigative testimony. Krivda was originally indicted in January 1988, along with Barry J. Minkow and 10 other co-defendants, in connection with violations stemming from the operation of ZZZZ Best Co., Inc. Krivda subsequently pled guilty to a one-count superseding information alleging that he violated 18 USC \$1001 in investigative testimony before the staff of the Commission. (U.S. v. Edward M. Krivda, CR No. 88-22(a)-DT, CDCA). (LR-12023)
