COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

CHANGE IN WEEKLY CALENDAR

The authorization hearing, previously announced as scheduled for April 6th, has been postponed. A new date will be announced shortly.

SEC/NASAA HEARINGS CANCELLED

The Commission and the North American Securities Administrators Association Inc. (NASAA) scheduled a public hearing to be held on April 7 to consider the views of the public, self-regulatory organizations and others in connection with the 1989 Conference on Federal-State Securities Regulation. Inasmuch as only two witnesses were scheduled to testify, the public hearing has been cancelled. The Conference will take place as scheduled on April 26.

STAFF ACCOUNTING BULLETIN NO. 81

The staff released Staff Accounting Bulletin No. 81, which expresses the staff's views regarding the appropriateness of gain recognition on the sale of a business or operating assets when there are uncertainties regarding the seller's ability to realize non-cash proceeds. The SAB also states the staff's views as to when recognition of any deferred gain should occur. (Rel. SAB-81)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

STOP ORDER ENTERED AGAINST CTI TECHNICAL, INC.

The Commission suspended the effectiveness of the registration statement of CTI Technical, Inc. The Commission also entered Findings and a Stop Order Imposed by Default against CTI.

The Commission found that the registration statement contained untrue statements of material facts and omitted material facts required to be stated therein or necessary to make the statements made not misleading including, but not limited to, the following: corporate control was exercised by Edwin "Bud" Wheeler and not by the officers and directors disclosed in the registration statement; Bud Wheeler's role was never disclosed; one of the directors was shown as owning 80% of the issued and outstanding shares of CTI at the time the registration statement became effective when in fact the director owned only 25%; and the remaining stock was owned by a company controlled by Bud Wheeler. The Commission also found that the units offered in the IPO had not been registered in any state in which they were offered or sold, resulting in contingent liabilities which have not been disclosed. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

GLOBAL INVESTMENT BROKERS, LIMITED AND WILLIAM H. KELLER TEMPORARILY RESTRAINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on March 9 Judge Moran, Northern District of Illinois, entered a Temporary Restraining Order against Global Investment Brokers, Limited and William H. Keller. On March 20, Judge Moran extended the TRO, by consent, through June 19. The Order temporarily restrains defendants from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws and freezes the assets held by defendants.

The Complaint alleges that from about 1987 to the present, defendants offered and sold unregistered securities in the form of evidences of indebtedness and investment contracts to an unknown number of investors located throughout the United States, thereby raising about \$1.4 million. It further alleges that defendants made material misrepresentations to investors concerning, among other things, returns to be expected, the risks associated with the investment, and the tax-free nature of income from the investment. It also seeks Preliminary and Permanent Injunctions and Equitable Relief in the form of Accountings and Disgorgement. (SEC v. Global Investment Brokers, Limited, et al., USDC NDIL, 89 C 1946). CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

DEAN S. LEMMON SENTENCED

The Denver Regional Office, the Salt Lake City Branch Office, and the U.S. Attorney for the District of Utah announced that on March 20 U.S. District Judge David Sam sentenced Dean S. Lemmon, of Holladay, Utah, to three years probation as a result of his having entered a plea of guilty to a one-count felony Information. The Information charged Lemmon with one count of conspiracy to commit securities, wire, and bank fraud.

Lemmon is named as an unindicted co-conspirator in a 36-count indictment filed January 18. The indictment alleges that Lemmon, three indicted co-conspirators, and five other unindicted co-conspirators played parts in an FBI sting operation. It further alleges that an entity known as Protecto Industries, Inc. was fraudulently made into a public vehicle, claimed nonexistent assets of nearly \$1 million, and was listed in the pink sheets. Finally, it alleges that manipulated trades of Protecto's stock were to take place to artificially inflate the value of its shares, and the stock was then to be pledged as collateral for a loan from a federally-insured bank. Lemmon's role in the scheme is said to have been as a go-between and as a facilitator. (U.S. v. Dean S. Lemmon, USDC DUT, Central Division, Criminal Action No. 89-CR-0002S). (LR-12053)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

DLJ ACCEPTANCE CORPORATION

An order has been issued on an application filed by DLJ Acceptance Corporation (DLJAC) and all trusts it may establish in the future either to issue bonds (the Trusts) or to acquire bond collateral (the Acquiring Trusts) (the Trusts and Acquiring Trusts together, the DLJ Acceptance Trusts), exempting DLJAC and the DLJ Acceptance Trusts from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance of mortgage-backed bonds, election of REMIC status, and the sale of residual interests. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 24 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following company filed under Release 35-24849, dated March 30: NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY - a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation, National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation, Penn-York Energy Corporation, and Seneca Resources Corporation, whereby National will issue and sell, prior to December 31, 1990, up to an aggregate principal amount of \$250 million of its debt securities consisting of debentures and medium-term notes, the proceeds of which will be contributed to the Subsidiaries.

UNLISTED TRADING SOUGHT

AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION

The International Securities Clearing Corporation filed an application for registration as a clearing agency under Section 17A of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The application was amended several times, most recently on March 30. The most recent amendment concerns a request for exemption from Section 17A(b)(3)(C) of the Exchange Act.
