## RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

---

### REVISED DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY IN ADJUDICATIVE MATTERS

The Commission adopted revisions to its rules reflecting the consolidation of the Commission's Office of Opinions and Review into the Office of the General Counsel. On February 9, the functions of the Office of Opinions and Review were transferred to the Office of the General Counsel, except that the Executive Assistant to the Chairman will perform such functions with respect to (1) contested cases under Rule 2(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, and (2) other cases in which the Chairman or the General Counsel determines that separation of functions requirements or other circumstances would make inappropriate the General Counsel's exercise of such functions. The rule revisions reflecting this transfer include (1) amendments to the position descriptions of the General Counsel and the Executive Assistant and rescission of the position description of the Director of Opinions and Review; and (2) amendments to the rule delegating authority to the General Counsel, adoption of a rule delegating authority to the Executive Assistant, and rescission of the rule delegating authority to the Director of Opinions and Review. The rule revisions become effective immediately upon publication in the Federal Register. (Rel. 33-6833)

## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

---

### ORDER AFFIRMING FOIA OFFICER'S DETERMINATION

The General Counsel sent a letter to Joan H. Boyce affirming the FOIA Officer's determination to deny access to certain information, the disclosure of which would result in harm to a Commission investigation. The General Counsel denied access under Exemption 7(A), 5 USC 552b(7)(A), to any transcripts of witnesses' investigatory testimony. Release of any responsive documents would reveal the theory of the staff's case, would provide an opportunity for witnesses to alter testimony, and would otherwise impede the Commission's investigation. The General Counsel's letter rejects the argument that, because a witness in a Commission investigation might be able to obtain a copy of his or her transcript under Rule 6 of the Commission's Rules Relating to Investigations, the Commission is compelled to release such transcripts to FOIA requesters. ## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

---

### THOMAS J. HERZFELD ADVISORS (CANADA) INC.

An order has been issued conditionally exempting Thomas J. Herzfeld Advisors (Canada) Inc., on behalf of T.J. Herzfeld Discount Asset Fund, from all provisions of Section 12(d)(1)(A) of the Investment Company Act to permit the Fund, an unregistered Canadian closed-end fund holding company, to invest in the securities in the United States registered closed-end investment companies. ### VARIABLE LIFE INVESTMENT FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 19 to request a hearing on an application filed by Variable Life Investment Fund seeking an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16939 - Apr. 25)

## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

A supplemental order has been issued releasing jurisdiction over certain portions of a proposal by The Columbia Gas System, Inc. (Columbia), a registered holding company, and certain of its subsidiaries, including Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc., Columbia Gas of Virginia, Inc., Commonwealth Gas Pipeline Corporation, Commonwealth Gas Services, Inc., Commonwealth Propane, Inc., and Columbia Gas System Service Corporation, whereby Columbia will increase the level of short and long-term intrasystem financing for the Subsidiaries, and adjust the interest rate formula to be applied to previously issued variable rate debt securities. Jurisdiction continues to be reserved over certain matters. (Rel. 35-24870 - Apr. 21)

### NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by National Fuel Gas Company (National), a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation, National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation, Penn-York Energy Corporation, and Seneca Resources Corporation, whereby National will issue and sell, prior to December 31, 1990, up to an aggregate principal amount of \$250 million of its debt securities consisting of debentures and medium-term notes, the proceeds of which will be contributed to the Subsidiaries.
