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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### COMPLAINT NAMES GARY VAN WAEYENBERGHE, OTHERS

The Commission filed a Complaint for Permanent Injunction and disgorgement on May 8 against Gary Van Waeyenberghe and Carl Leibowitz of South Bend, Indiana, and Howard K. Schwartz, an attorney residing in West Bloomfield, Michigan, charging them with violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

The Complaint alleges that defendants participated in the offer and sale of limited partnership interests in three partnerships which were to engage in the ethanol business in Eules, Texas and Wanatah, Indiana. Despite representations to return the offering proceeds plus interest to investors if the offerings were not sold in accordance with the terms of the offering memoranda, defendants failed to honor these commitments and utilized some of the funds raised for purposes unrelated to the businesses of the partnerships. Each offering memorandum also contained numerous false and misleading statements concerning the general partner and the financing and management of the issuers. (SEC v. Gary Van Waeyenberghe, et al., Civil Action No. CA 4-89-376-E). (LR-12101)

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### CNG ENERGY COMPANY; THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until June 12 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24894, dated May 18: CNG ENERGY COMPANY - subsidiary of Consolidated Natural Gas Company, whereby the two companies propose to increase their investment arrangements in cogeneration projects from \$100 million up to \$289 million, and to form a single purpose subsidiary to make such additional investments in the Lakewood Project located in Lakewood, New Jersey; THE SOUTHERN COMPANY - a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Alabama Power Company, Georgia Power Company, Gulf Power Company, Mississippi Power Company, Southern Company Services, Inc., Southern Electric Generating Company, and Southern Electric International, Inc. Southern also proposes to acquire for its own account up to 15 million shares of its common stock presently outstanding, in negotiated or open market transactions or tender offers, from time to time through March 31, 1992.

A proposed rule change has been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-89-17) to clarify the rights and obligations of market participants in executing agency cross transactions. (Rel. 34-26832); and (SR-Phlx-89-15) to clarify equity opening procedures for dually traded securities when the primary market is subject to a non-regulatory trading halt. (Rel. 34-26835); and The American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-89-10) relating to bid/ask differentials and the responsibility of specialists to make ten-up markets for public customer orders. (Rel. 34-26834)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of May 22.

### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-89-23) which became effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposed changes are technical changes to the language of provisions of the NASD Code of Arbitration which, in one provision cross-references the wrong provision of the NASD By-Laws and, in the other provision, refers in a footnote to a case which no longer reflects NASD policy regarding arbitrability of disputes and which recently has been overruled by the U.S. Supreme Court.
