# **COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS**

ORDER AFFIRMING IN PART AND REVERSING IN PART FOIA OFFICER'S DETERMINATION

The General Counsel sent a letter to Larry F. Brungardt affirming in part and reversing in part the FOIA Officer's determination to deny access to certain information compiled by the Commission for law enforcement purposes concerning Goldcor, Inc., and American Assurance Underwriters Group. The General Counsel denied access under Exemption 5, 5 U.S.C. Section 552(b)(5), and 7(A), 5 U.S.C. Section 552(b)(7)(A), to some of the information withheld by the FOIA Officer, and released certain information that the FOIA Officer had withheld pursuant to Exemption 7(A). (Rel. FOIA-112)

FRIEND-OF-THE-COURT BRIEF FILED

Daniel L. Goelzer, the General Counsel of the Securities and Exchange Commission, today announced that the Commission has filed a friend-of-the-court brief with the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit in Consolidated Gold Fields PLC, et al. v. Anglo American Corporation of South Africa Limited. The case involves a tender offer made by a foreign company for the shares of another foreign company, 97.5 percent of which are held by foreign residents. The brief argues that since the bidder sent offering materials to persons who were known by the bidder to be foreign-based agents for U.S. resident shareholders, a U.S. court has subject-matter jurisdiction over an allegation that the offering documents violate U.S. antifraud laws. However, the brief also argues that on the facts of this case, a court must abstain from granting relief that would enjoin the tender offer worldwide. (Rel. IS-100)

SECOND CIRCUIT OPINION ON INTERNATIONAL JURISDICTION

The U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit issued an opinion in Consolidated Gold Fields PLC, et al. v. Anglo American Corporation of South Africa Limited, a case in which the Securities and Exchange Commission filed a friend-of-the-court brief. The case involves a tender offer made by a foreign company for the shares of another foreign company, 97.5 percent of which are held by foreign residents. The decision agrees with the position taken by the Commission, that since the bidder sent offering materials to persons who were known by the bidder to be foreign-based agents for U.S. resident shareholders, a U.S. court has subject-matter jurisdiction over an allegation that the offering documents violate U.S. antifraud laws. The Second Circuit declined to adopt the Commission's second argument, that on the facts before it, a court must abstain from granting relief that would enjoin the tender offer worldwide, and instead remanded for further fact-finding. # CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

ASCO ADVISORY SERVICES CORP. PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Commission filed a Complaint in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of New York against ASCO Advisory Services Corp. (ASCO), a financial planning corporation, alleging that ASCO violated the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws by recommending investments in Broadhollow Funding Corporation

(Broadhollow) without adequately investigating the investment. ASCO recommended investments in Broadhollow, the Complaint alleges, without ever reviewing Broadhollow's financial statements and without adequately reviewing mortgage papers, appraisal reports, title searches or insurance policies pertaining to property which would purportedly secure an investment. The Complaint also alleges that Broadhollow issued unregistered securities, commingled investor funds in its general corporate account and used proceeds from new investors to pay "interest" to previous investors.

Without admitting or denying the allegations, ASCO contemporaneously consented to the entry of a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction permanently enjoining it from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws and ordering it to disgorge \$325,000 of the commissions it earned in connection with the sale of Broadhollow securities. (SEC v. ASCO Advisory Services Corp., USDC, EDNY (89 Civ. 1724)) (Rel. LR-12116)

#### JAMES M. HORAN SR. PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on May 23 the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas entered orders of permanent injunction against James M. Horan, Sr., James M. Horan, Jr., Plaino Oil & Gas, Inc., and Odaat Petroleum, Inc., enjoining them from further violations of the securities and broker-dealer registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The defendants were also ordered to disgorge the funds they obtained as a result of their alleged fraudulent activity; however, payment was waived based upon their demonstrated financial inability to pay. The defendants consented to the orders without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations against them.

The Commission's Complaint alleges that the defendants sold unregistered interests in oil and gas wells through unregistered commissioned sales persons, raising some \$2.7 million from 230 investors. The complaint also alleges the written and oral presentations made by the defendants involved false and misleading statements of material facts regarding the possible productivity of wells, actual costs of drilling operations, and the use of investors' funds. (SEC v. James M. Horan, Sr., et al., USDC NDTX CA3-89-1369-R) (LR-12117)

#### HIEX DEVELOPMENT USA, INC. ENJOINED

The Denver Regional Office, on May 30, filed a Complaint in the U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado naming as defendant Hiex Development USA, Inc. (Hiex) of Lakewood, Colorado, and seeking to enjoin Hiex from future violations of Section 12(g) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 12b-20.

The Commission's Complaint alleges, among other things, that Hiex filed a Form 10 Registration statement that was materially deficient and contained false and misleading financial statements which were not prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles in that the Form 10: contained financial statements that improperly valued certain assets and contained inadequate or inaccurate disclosures regarding certain transactions entered into by Hiex.

Also tendered to the court on May 30, simultaneously with the Complaint, was a consent to entry of a permanent injunction by which Hiex, without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint, consented to entry of the permanent injunction sought. The complaint and consent are pending before the court. (SEC v. Hiex Development USA, Inc., USDC Colorado, Civil Action No. 89-C-946) (LR-12118)
