## CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

---

### GULF POWER COMPANY PLEADS GUILTY

The Atlanta Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Northern District of Georgia announced that on October 31 Gulf Power Company of Pensacola, Florida, subsidiary of The Southern Company, pled guilty before U.S. District Judge Robert L. Vining, Jr. to a two-count criminal Information. The Information charges that Gulf Power conspired to make illegal political contributions in violation of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935 and conspired to defraud the United States by impeding and obstructing the Internal Revenue Service in the ascertainment of income taxes. The Information, filed on October 31, charged that Gulf Power repeatedly and willfully instructed several vendors to make political contributions on its behalf and directed the vendors to submit false and inflated invoices for reimbursement by Gulf Power for the contributions. Judge Vining imposed a \$500,000 fine on Gulf Power. (U.S. v. Gulf Power Company, Cr. No. 89-412-A, NDGA). (LR-12295)

## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until December 4 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24982, dated November 9: THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY (CL&P) - subsidiary of Northeast Utilities, regarding the financing of CL&P's share of the costs of acquiring, constructing, and installing certain pollution control and/or sewage or solid waste disposal facilities at the Seabrook Nuclear Power Station, Unit 1. CL&P proposes to issue one or more of its First and Refunding Mortgage Bonds, Series TT (First Mortgage Bond) in an amount of up to \$20 million for a term not to exceed 30 years to evidence its borrowing from the Industrial Development Authority of the State of New Hampshire. The borrowing under the financing agreement and the issuance of the First Mortgage Bond would be made pursuant to an exemption from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50 under Subsection (a)(5). The First Mortgage Bond would also be issued pursuant to a deviation from the Commission's Statement of Policy Regarding First Mortgage Bonds Subject to the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935.

### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change which became effective upon filing under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal (SR-NASD-89-51) pertains to the NASD's periodic reclassification of securities in the appropriate Small Order Execution System (SOES) maximum order-size tiers. The NASD reviews the tier levels applicable to each participating security periodically to determine if a SOES tier level change is warranted. (Rel. 34-27438)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
