ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST RICK EDWARD MYERS

The Commission instituted administrative proceedings against Rick E. Myers, doing business as Rick Edward Myers, CFP, of Ada, Michigan. The Order Instituting Public Proceedings alleges that Myers was permanently enjoined from future violations of Sections 5 and 17 of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5, and that he willfully violated those provisions of the securities laws. The Order also alleges that Myers failed to promptly amend his application for registration as an investment adviser to disclose his indictment on July 27, 1989 on 20 counts of mail fraud by a federal grand jury in Grand Rapids, Michigan.

A hearing will be scheduled to take evidence on the staff's allegations and to afford respondent an opportunity to present any defenses thereto. (Rel. 34-27457)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

DISTRICT COURT ENJOINS FREE-RIDERS

The Commission announced that on November 22 Judge Richard Owen, U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York, issued an Opinion and Order which granted the Commission's motion for a preliminary injunction and other relief against Jury Matt Hansen, Fergus Sloan, Jr., and Fermat Associates. The Commission had alleged that defendants engaged, from 1985 to 1989, in a massive "free-riding" scheme in which they would order for purchase hundreds of millions of dollars of securities in brokerdealer cash accounts without sufficient funds to pay for such securities. Instead, the Commission alleged that defendants paid for the securities purchases with the proceeds of the same day sale of the same securities, in violation of the antifraud and credit extension provisions of the securities laws. Judge Owen continued a freeze over the defendants' assets which had previously been in effect, until there is a final disposition of the matter. The Commission is seeking over \$3 million in disgorgement from defendants. (SEC v. Jury Matt Hansen, et al., USDC SDNY, 89 Civ. 5242, RO). (LR-12306)
