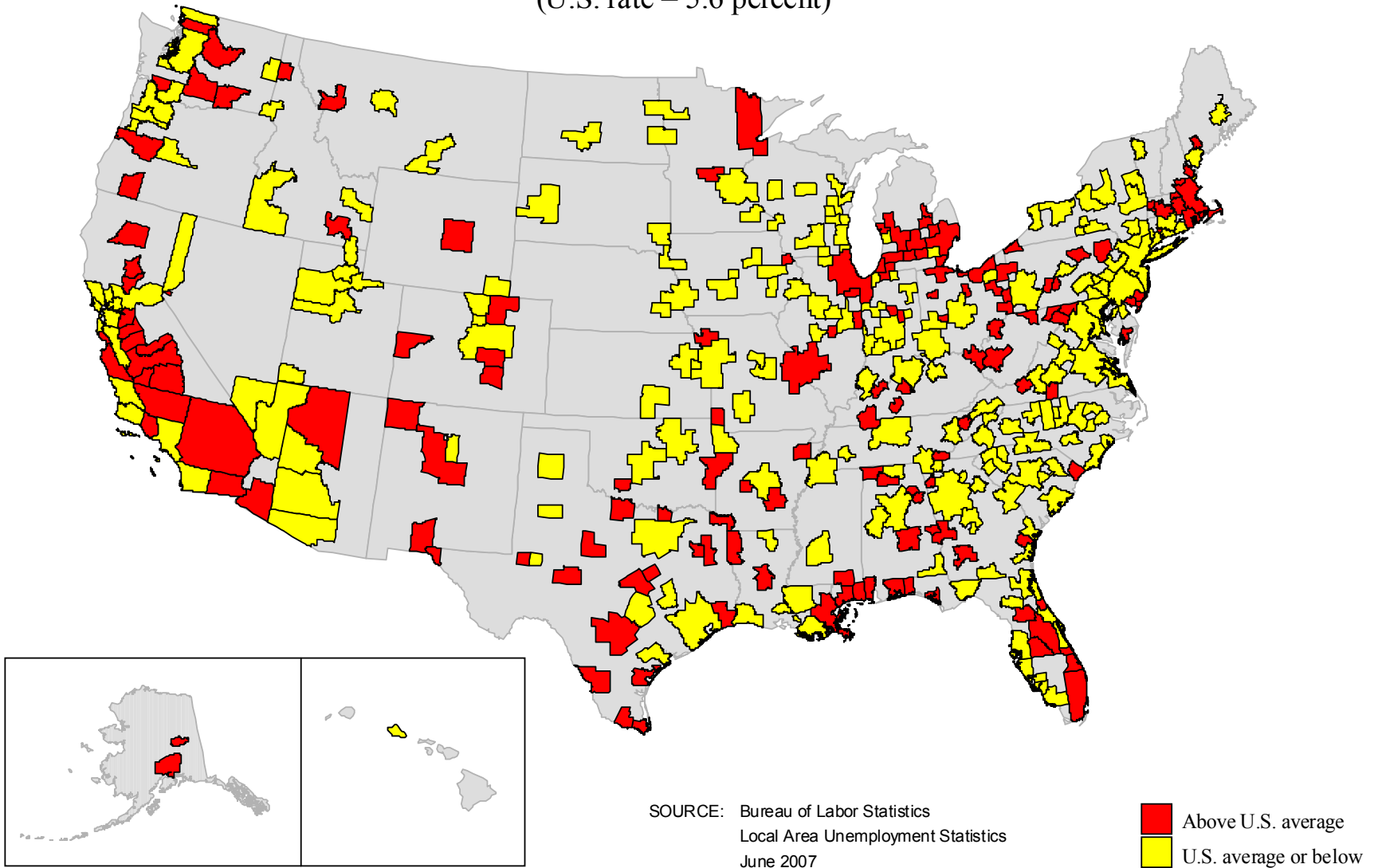


Unemployment rates by metropolitan area, 1990 annual averages

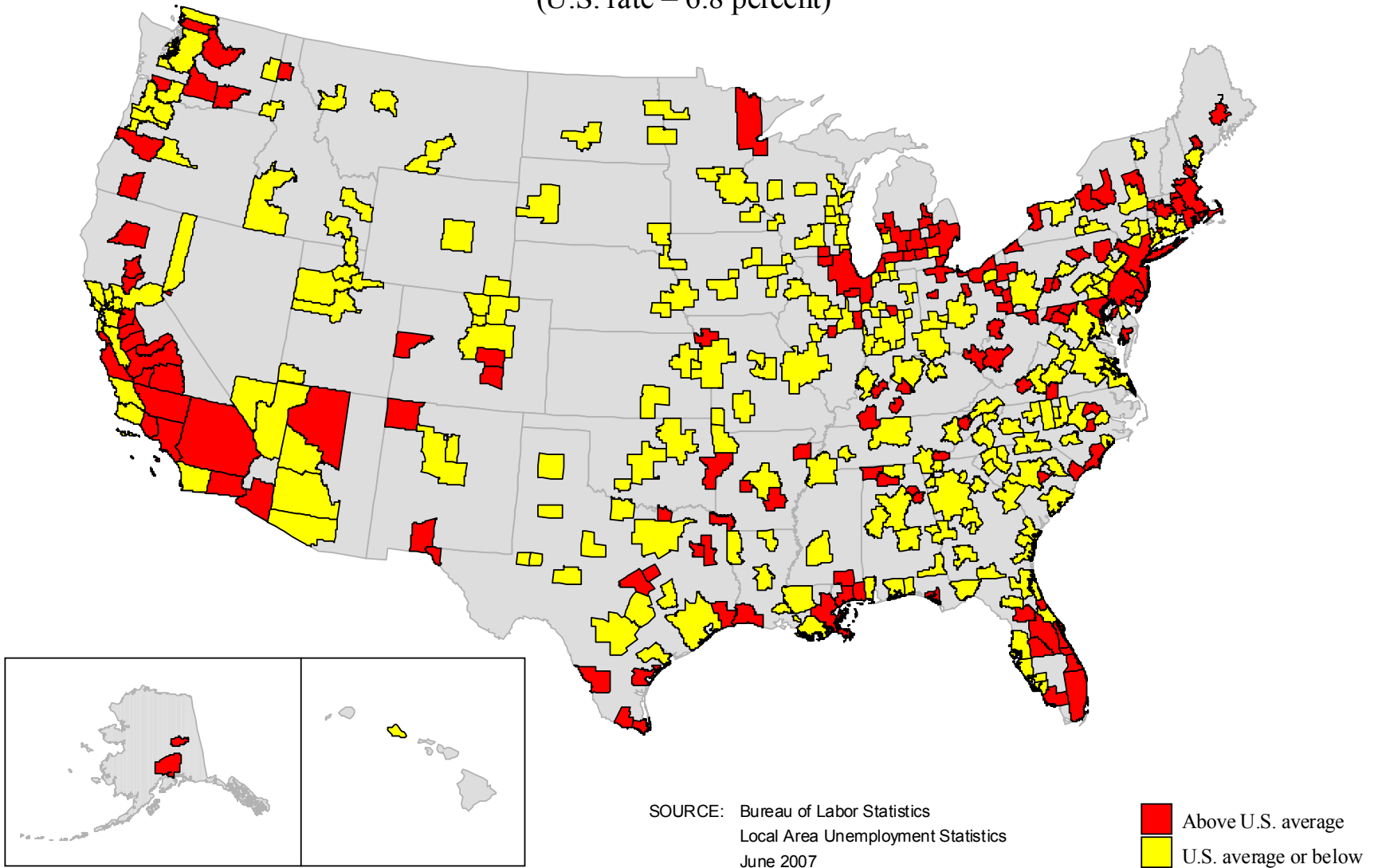

Unemployment rates by metropolitan area, 1991 annual averages

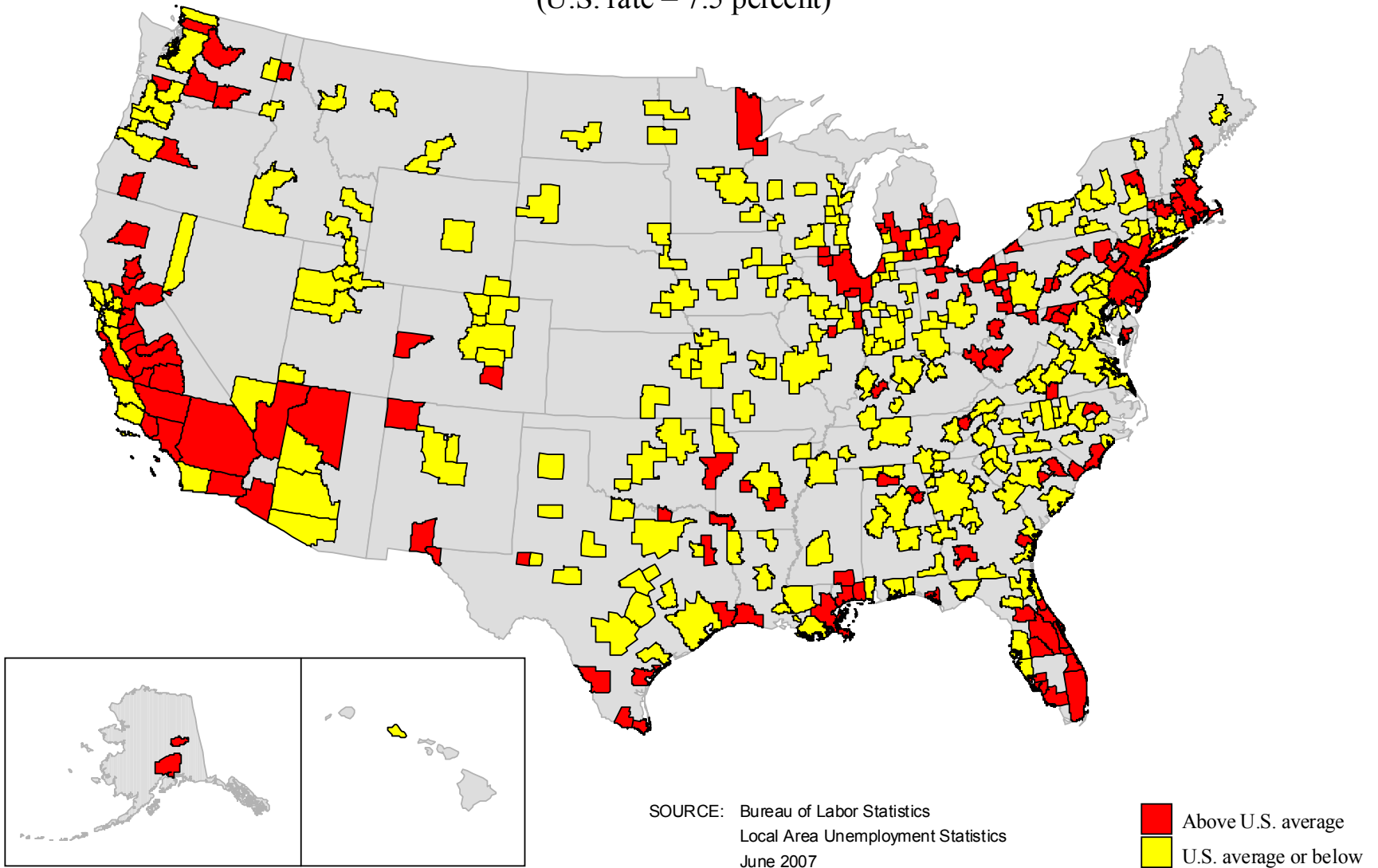

Unemployment rates by metropolitan area, 1992 annual averages

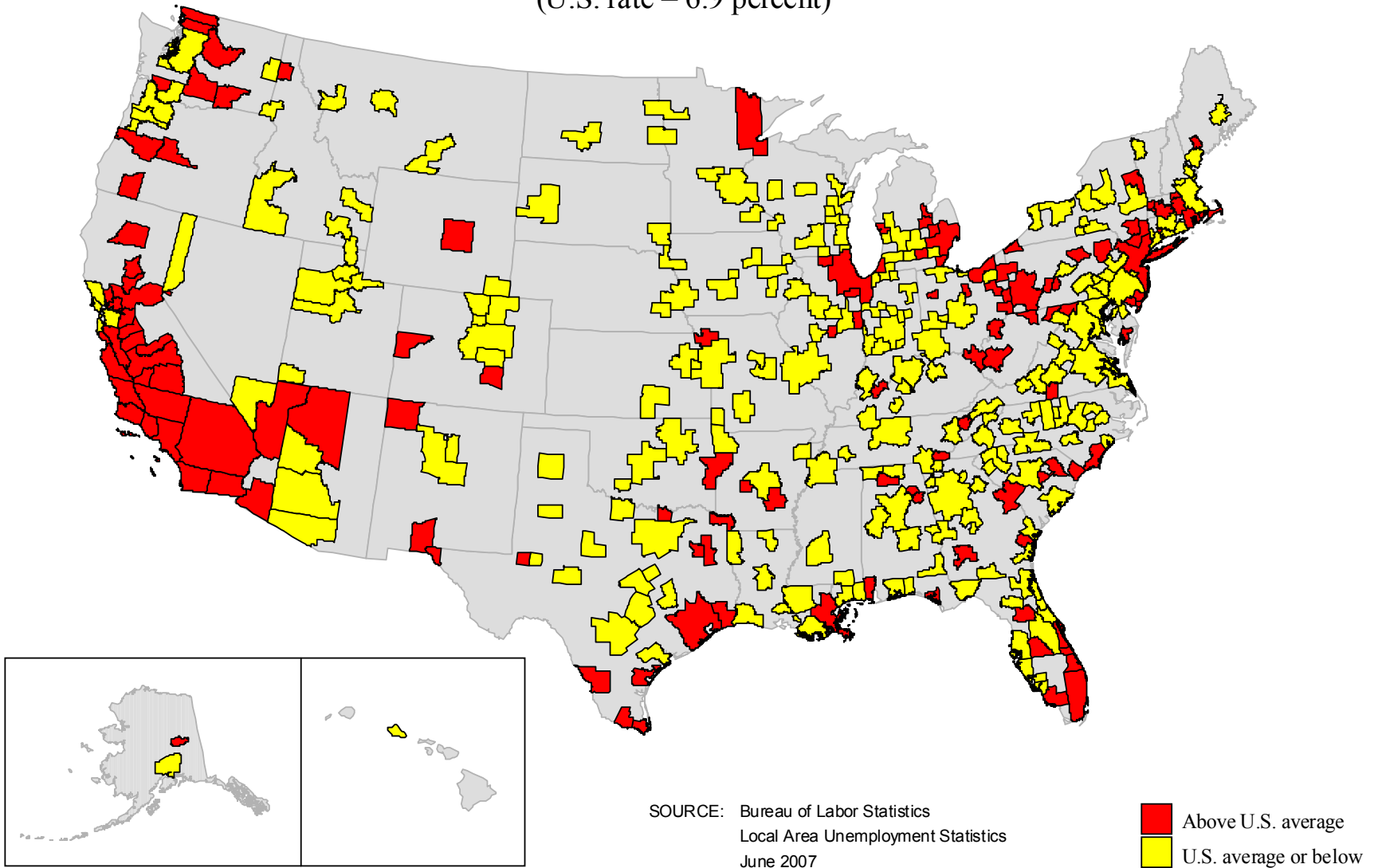

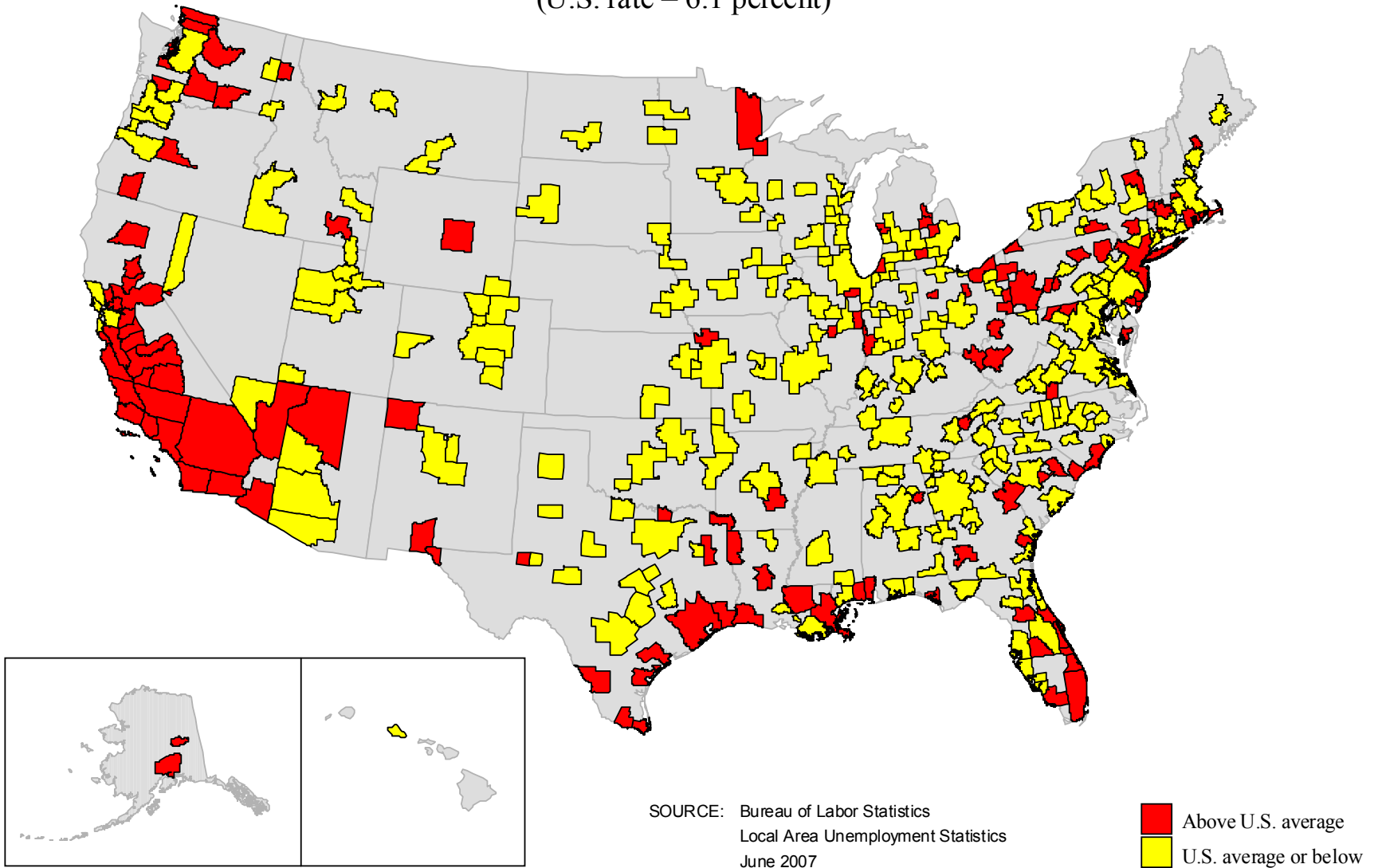

(U.S. rate = 6.1 percent)



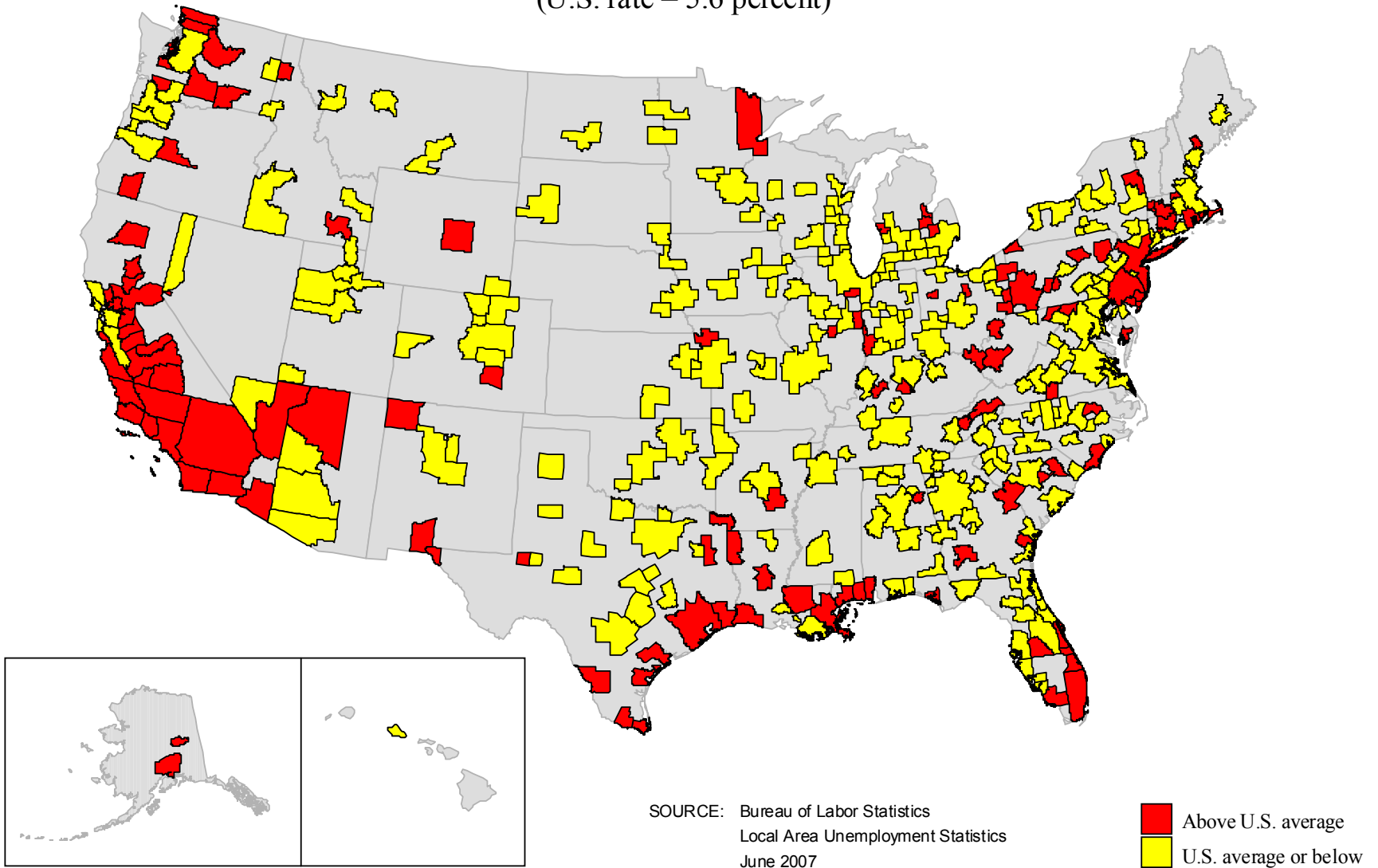

(U.S. rate = 5.6 percent)



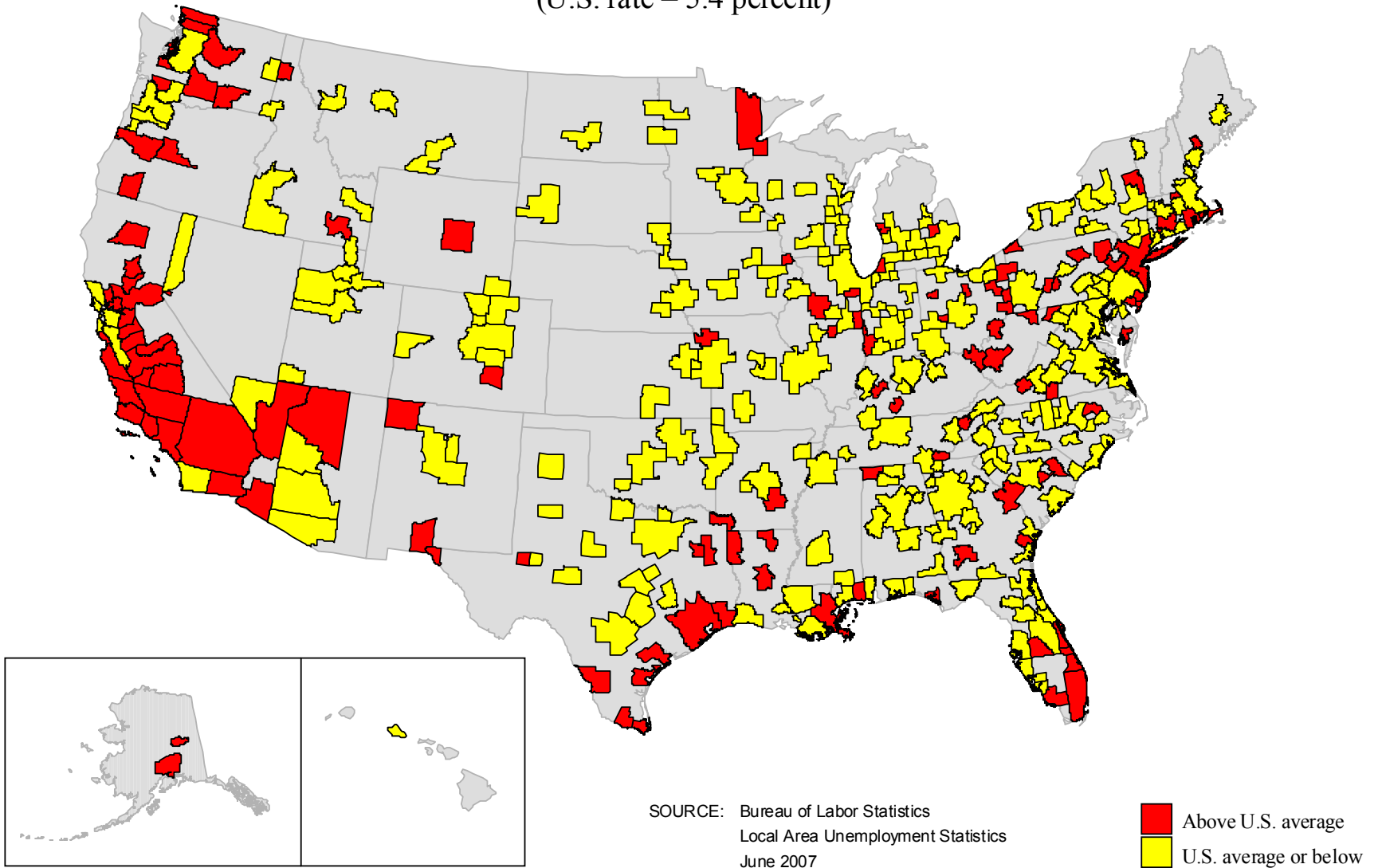

Unemployment rates by metropolitan area, 1996 annual averages

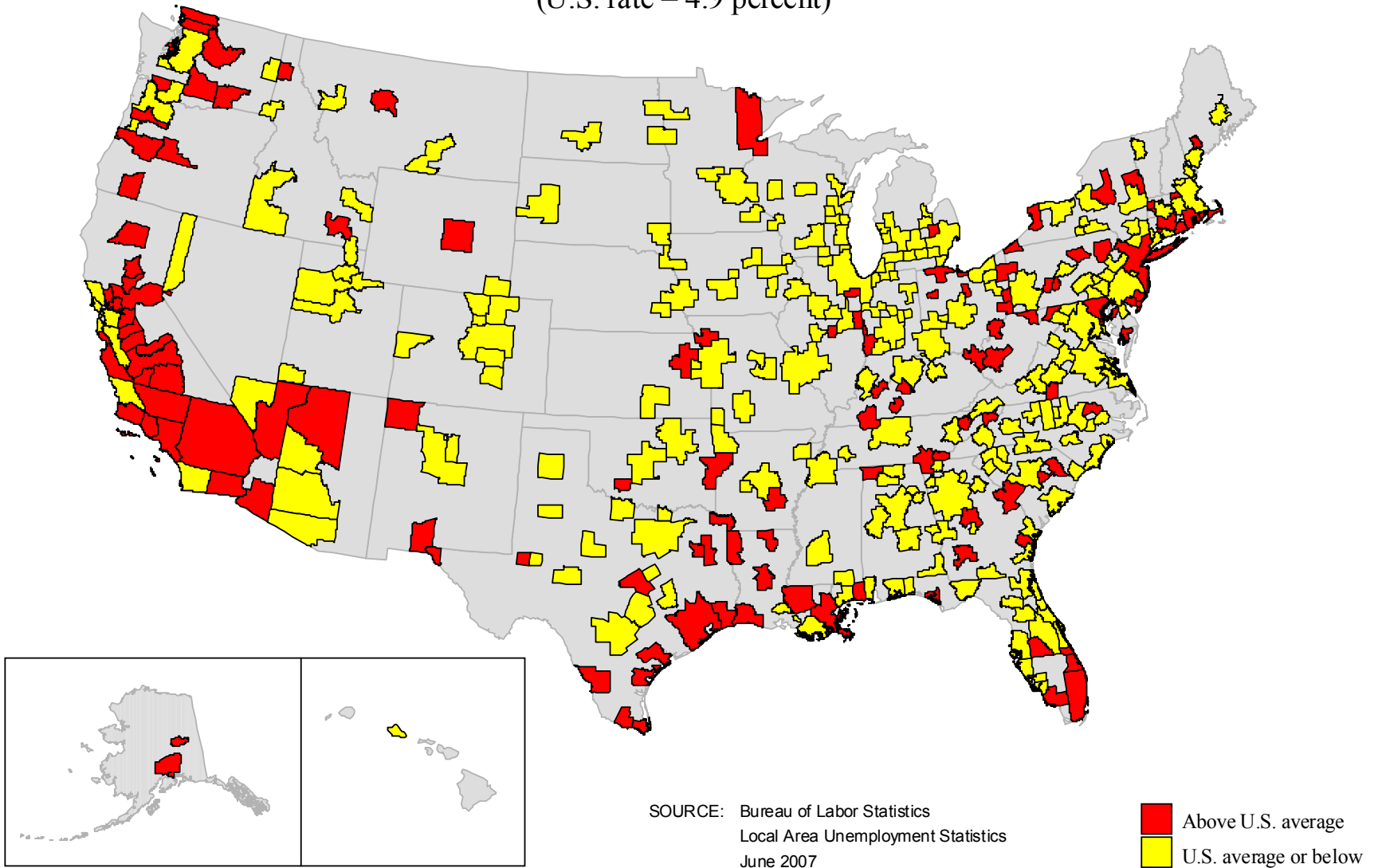

Unemployment rates by metropolitan area, 1997 annual averages

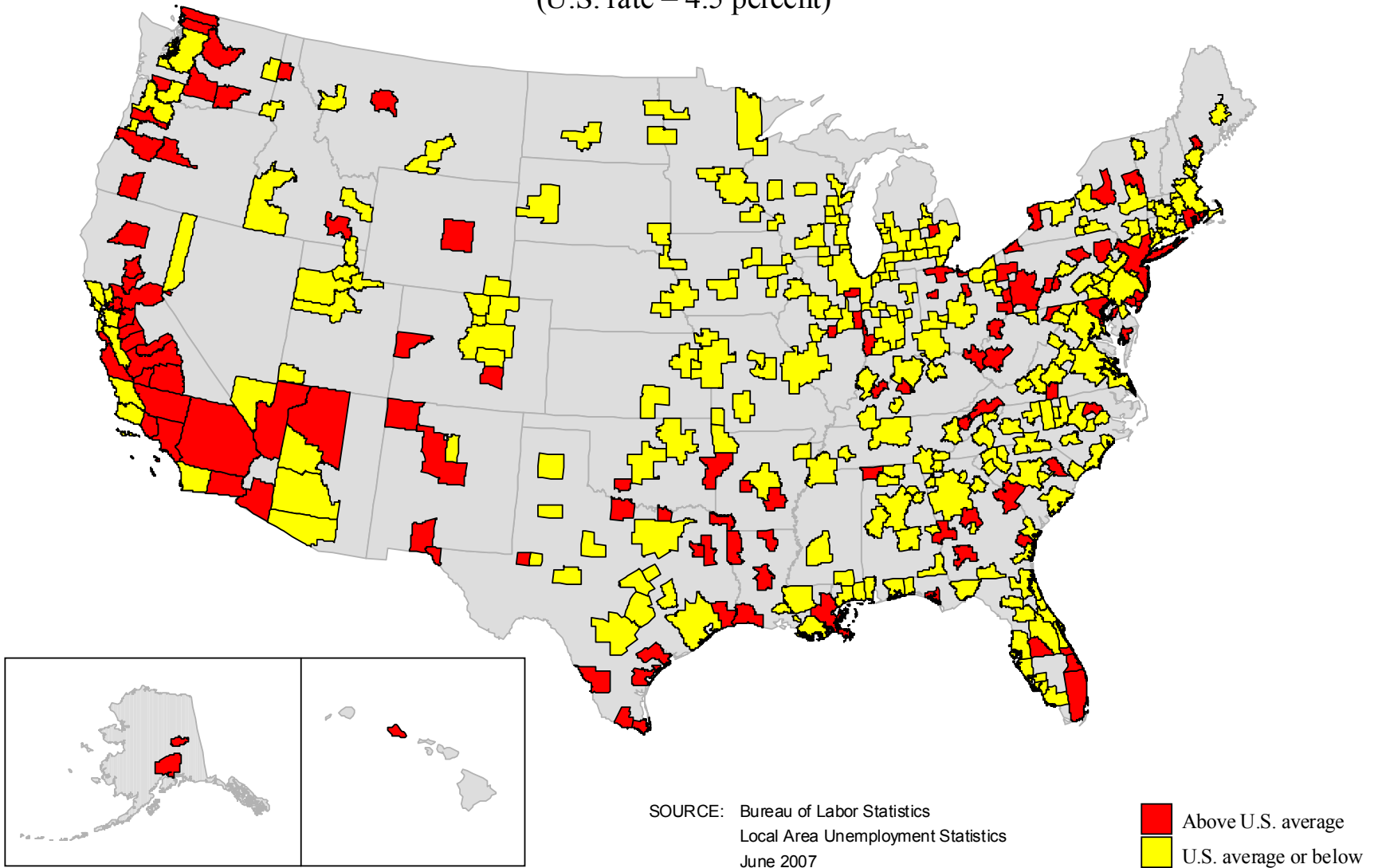

Unemployment rates by metropolitan area, 1998 annual averages

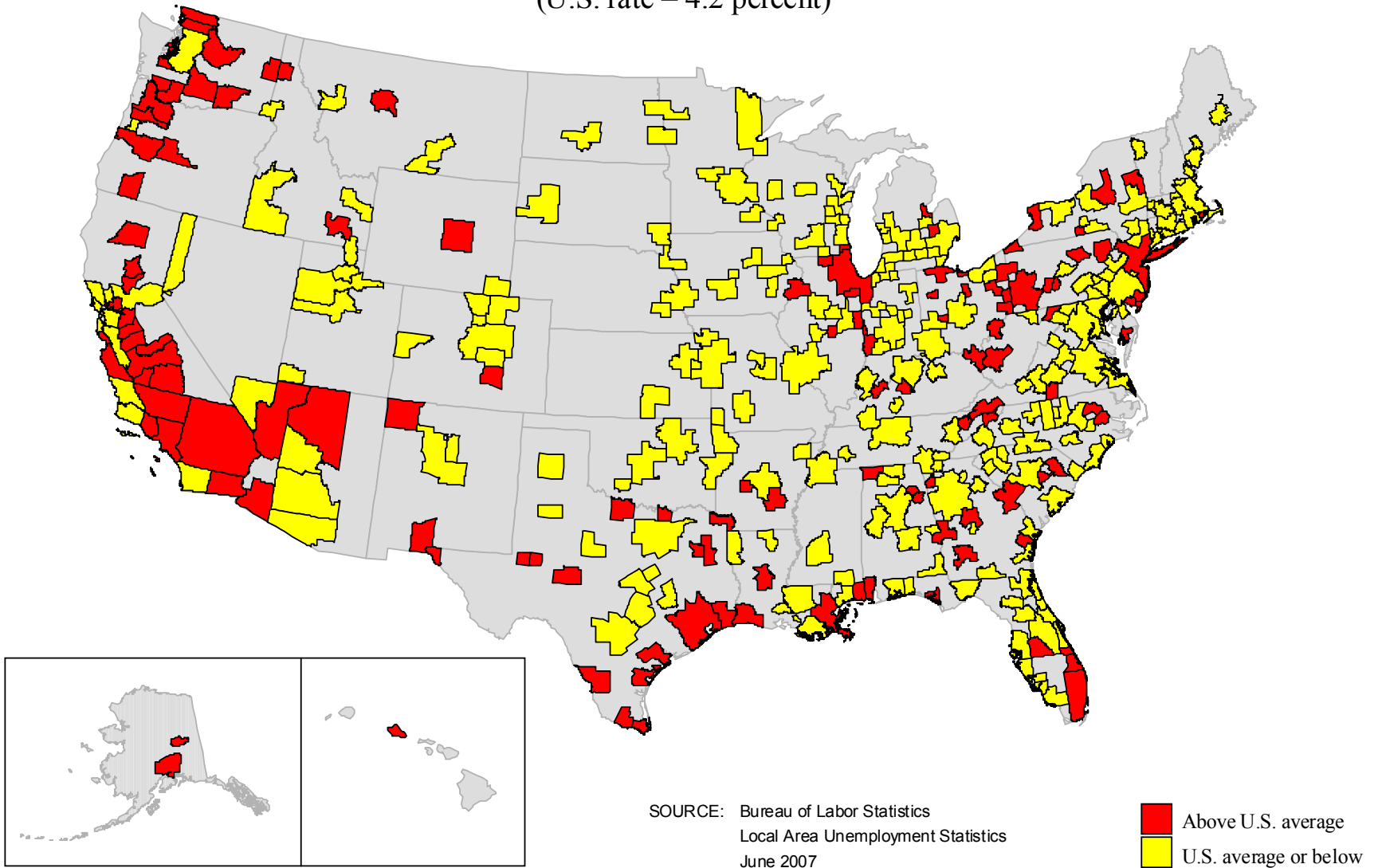

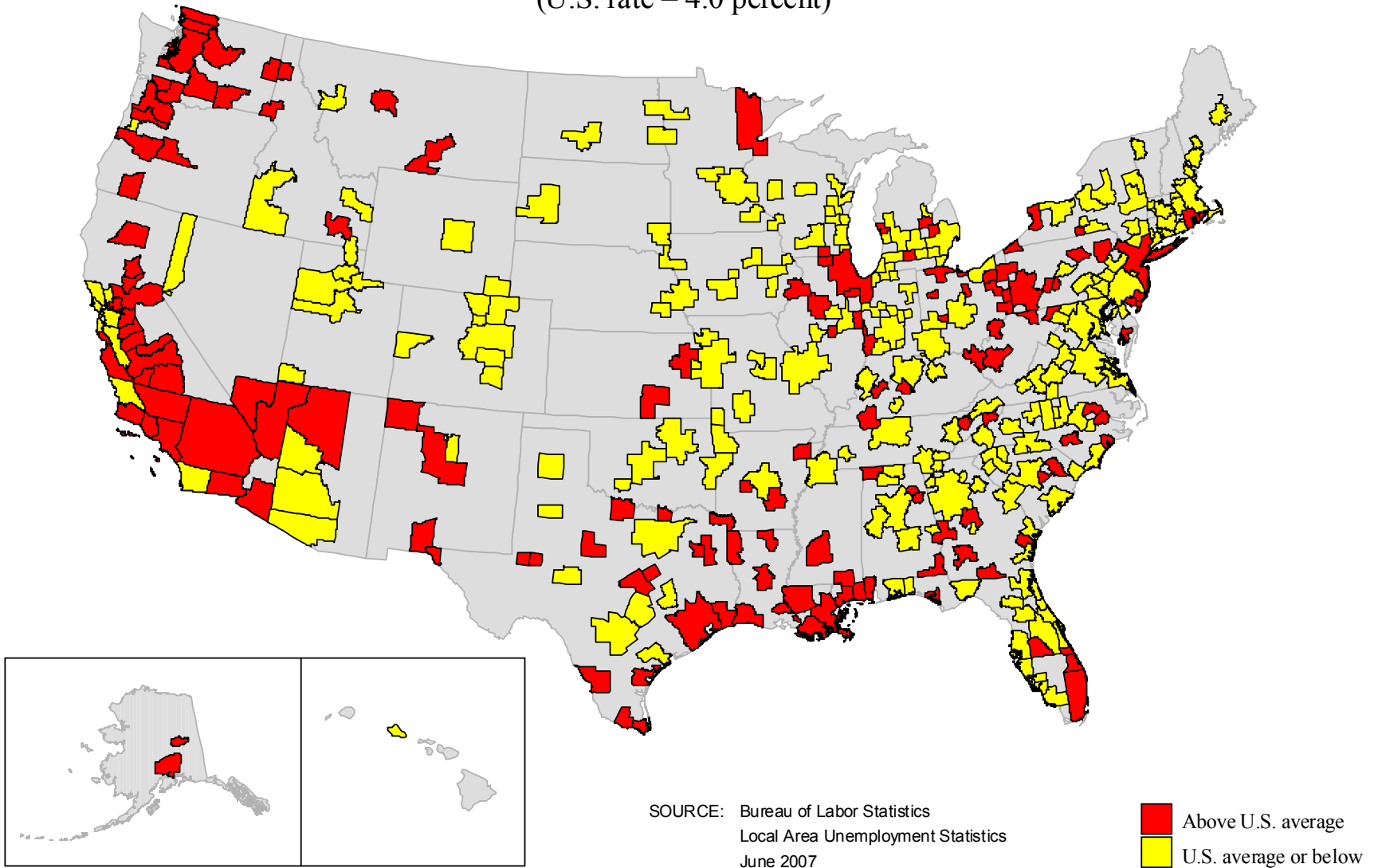

Unemployment rates by metropolitan area, 2000 annual averages

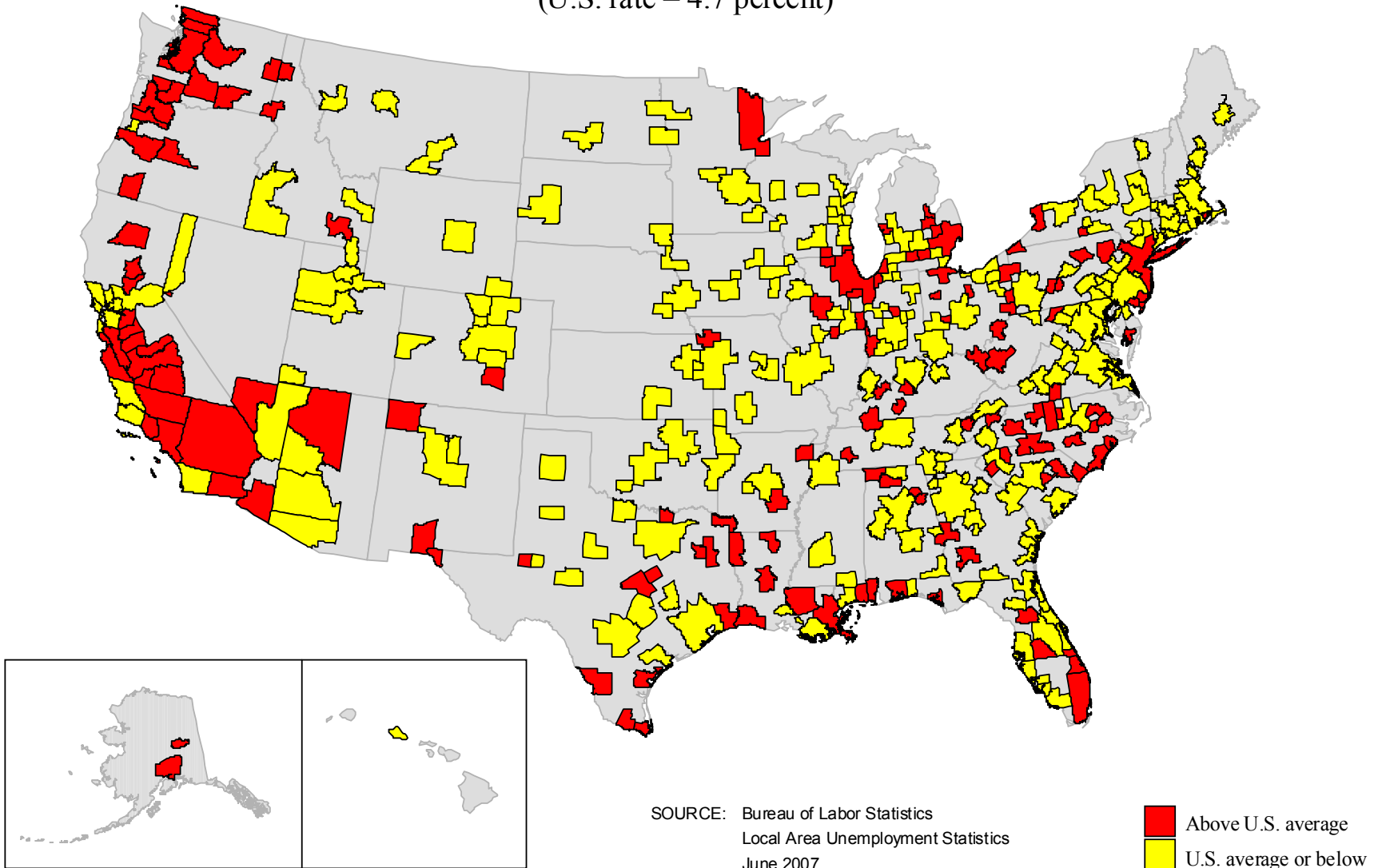

Unemployment rates by metropolitan area, 2001 annual averages

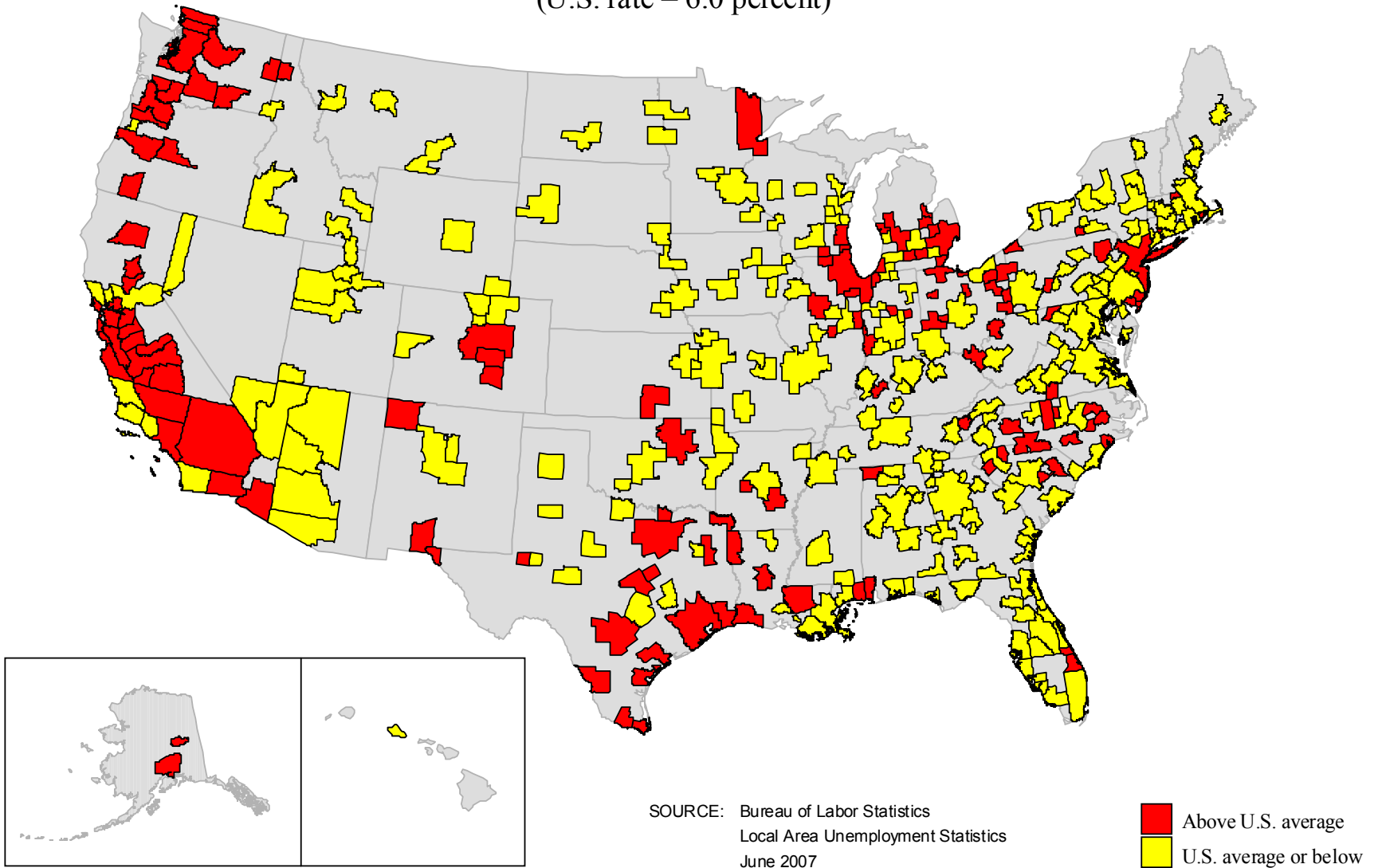

Unemployment rates by metropolitan area, 2003 annual averages

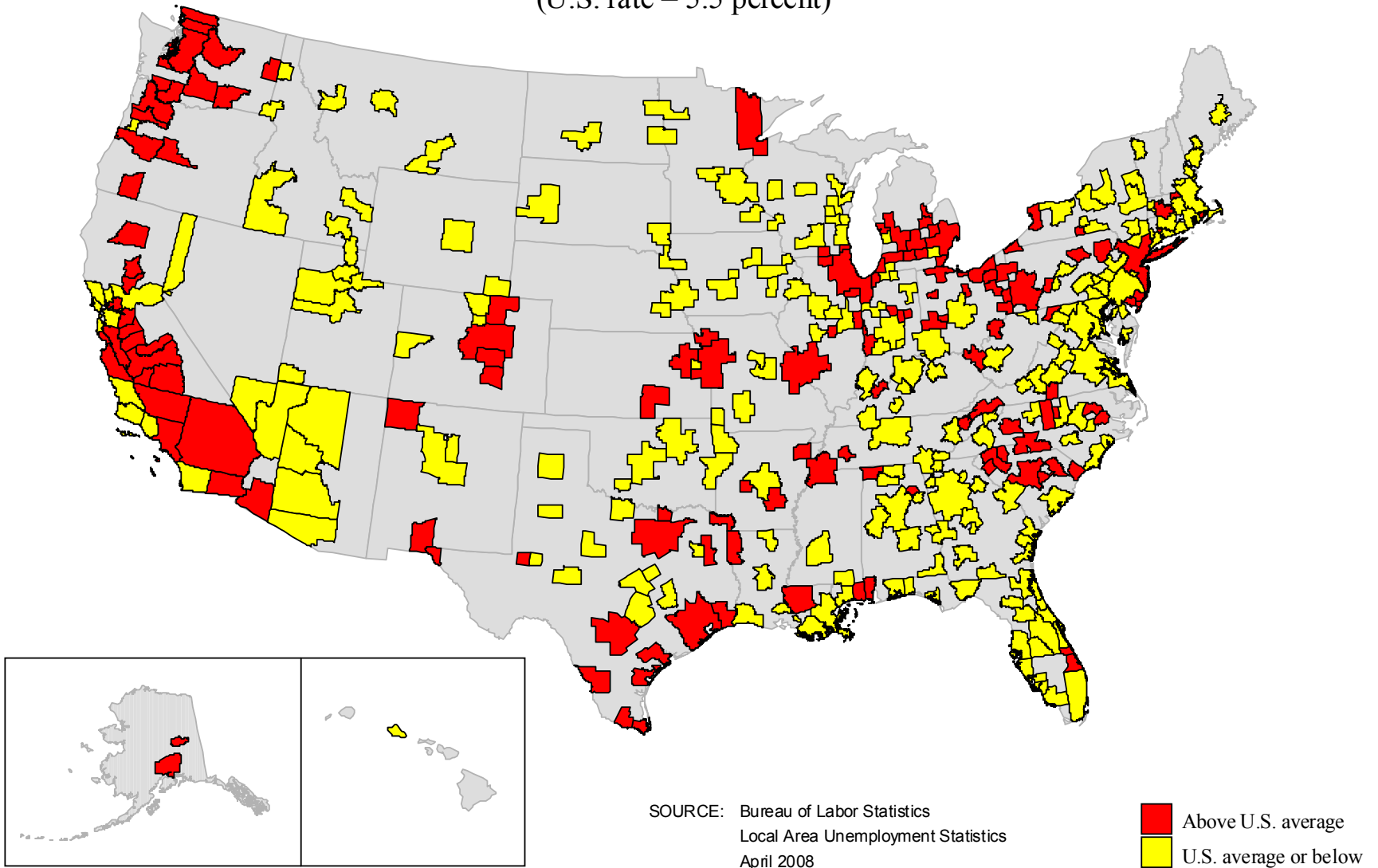

Unemployment rates by metropolitan area, 2004 annual averages

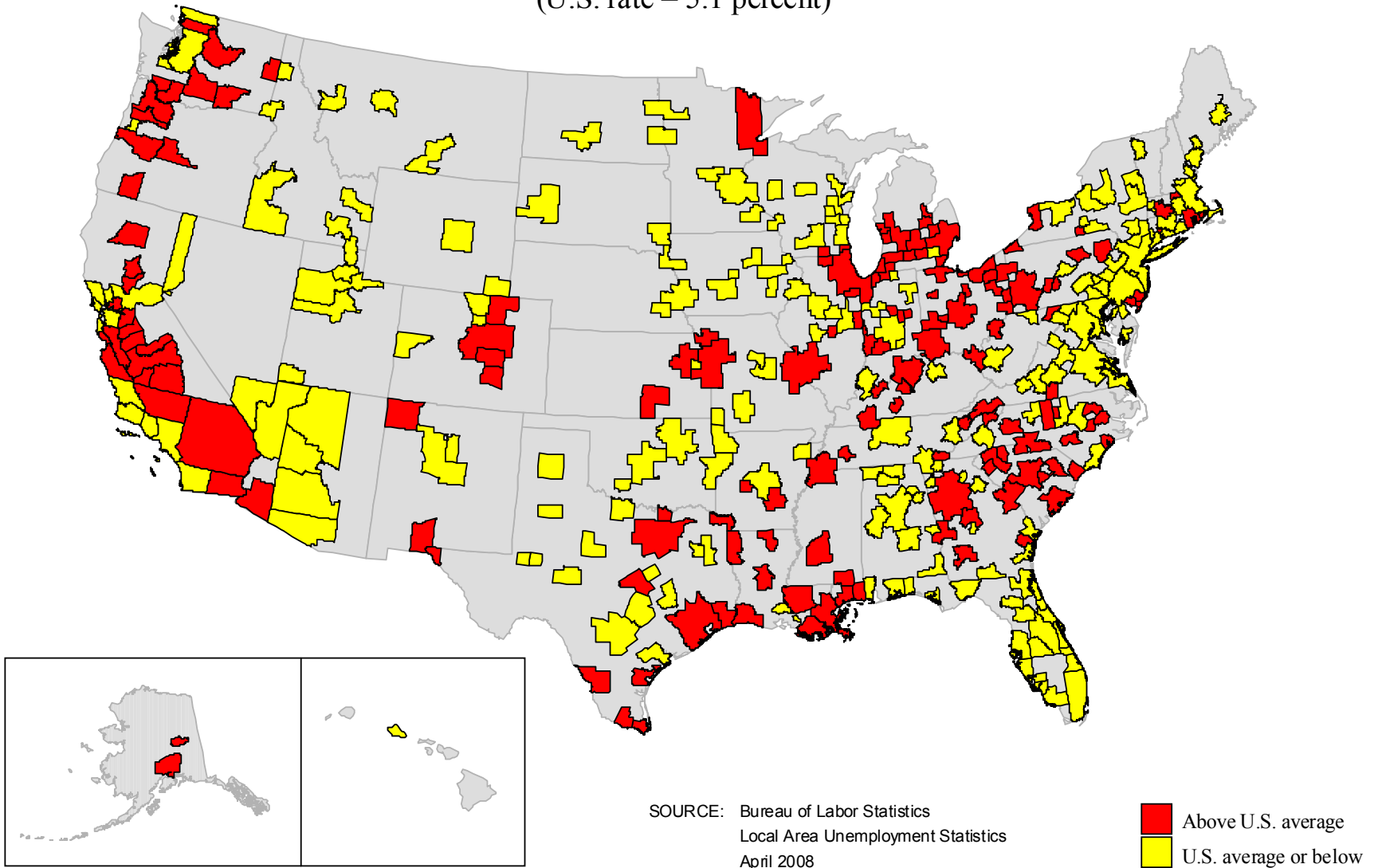

Unemployment rates by metropolitan area, 2005 annual averages

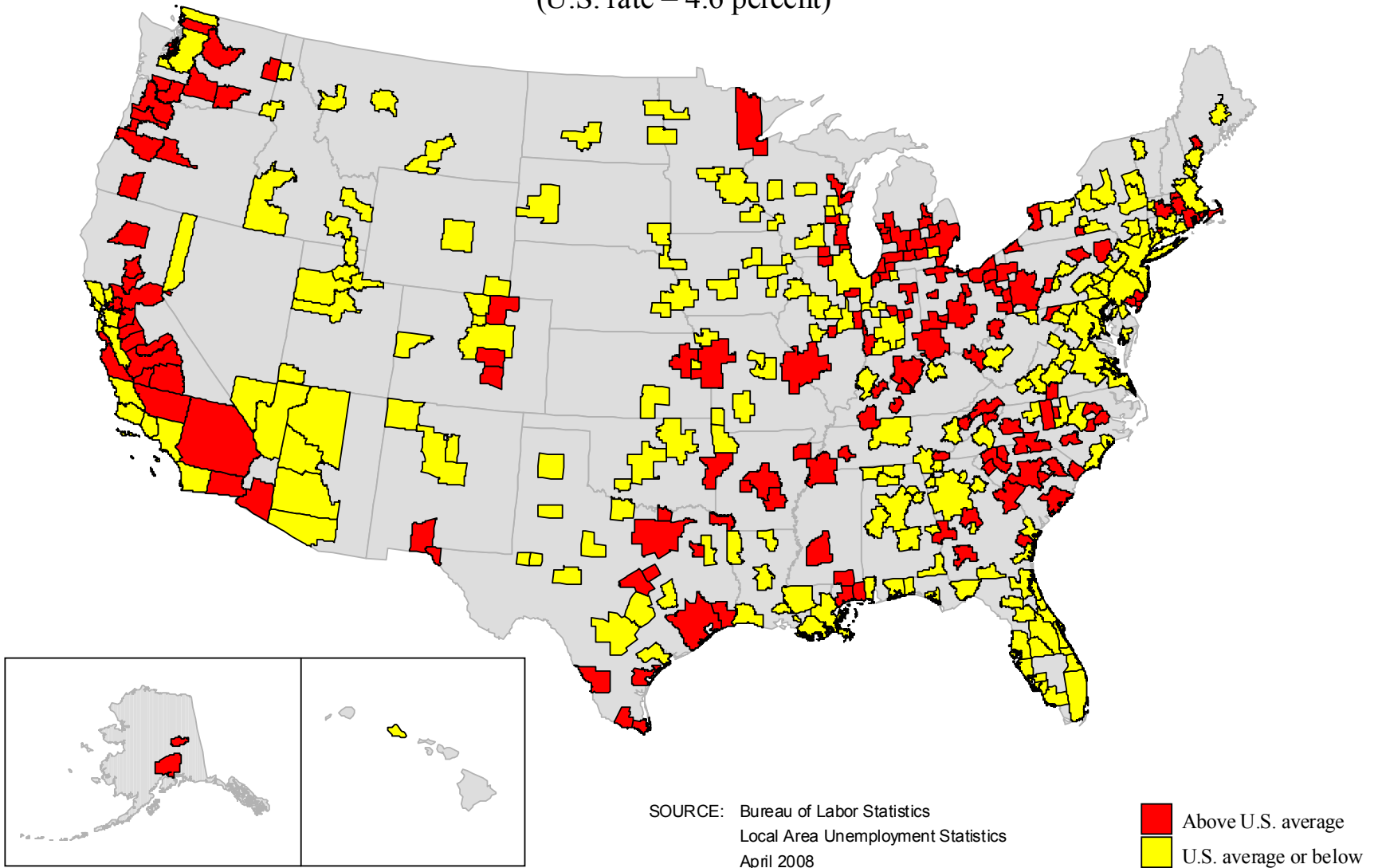

Unemployment rates by metropolitan area, 2006 annual averages

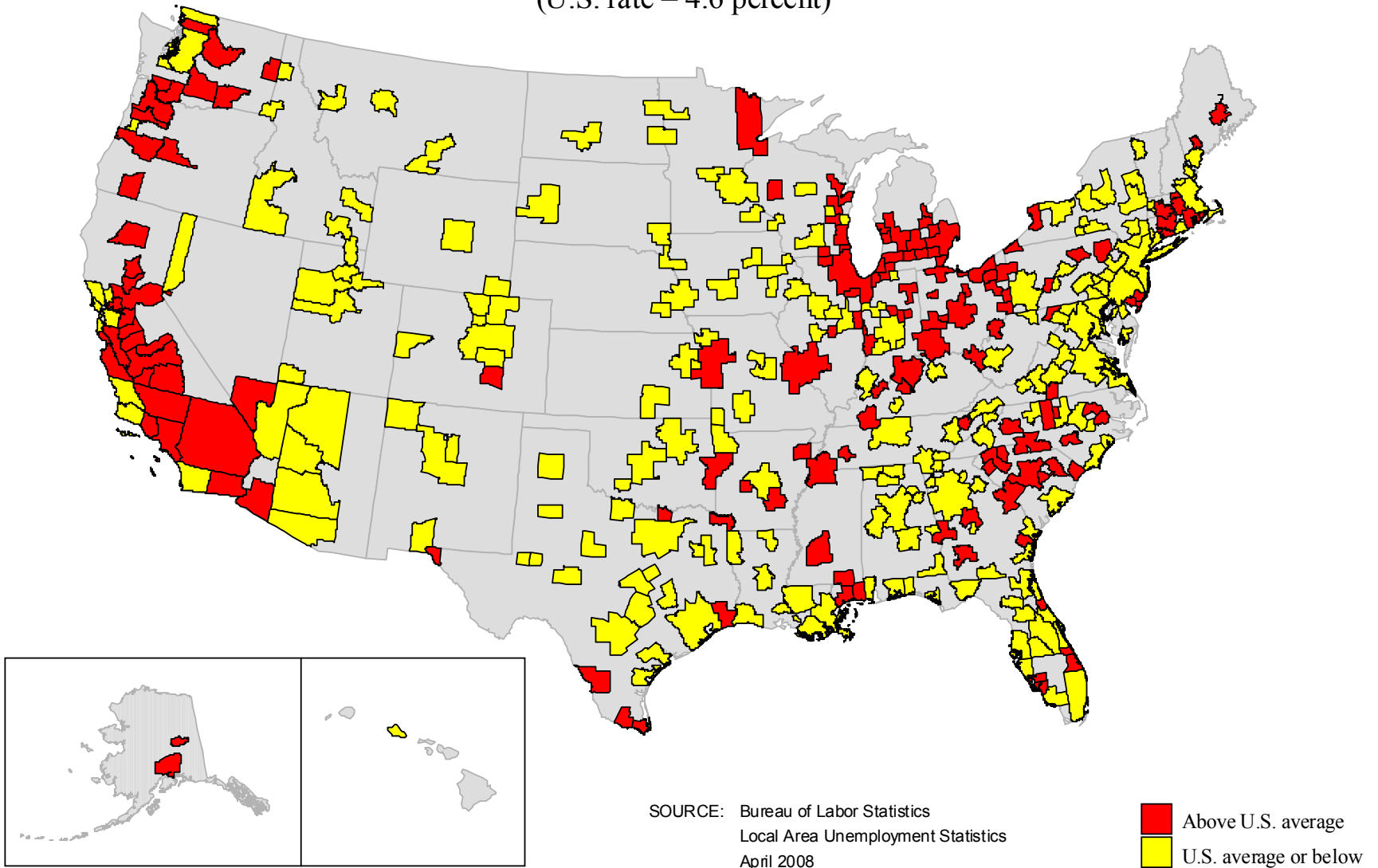
