Must keep goal, but performance indicators could be changed
Retain as is.
- Page 93** **C4: Goal 12: Mental Health Services for children who are homeless**
Review
We need to keep this goal as it’s part of Block Grant statutory criteria
Discuss with Rita McMillan in terms of transition age youth issues to see if we can make this one more meaningful
- Page 98** **C5: Goal 13: Family members technical advisory skill training**
Review
Revise, changing performance indicators to “meaningful youth guided involvement: measure number of youth trained and/or on councils/committees throughout the state
Suggestions: baseline year 2007–2008

50% increase by 6/10
60% increase by 6/11
