Policy Issues	<p>CSAC Work Plan/Transition Age Youth – Rita McMillan White paper (on buff) Reviewed and discussion on handout. The model program from New Zealand is for all transition age youth, just not special needs youth. All youth seek services for housing, job search and special needs in the same location. Oregon currently has a program like this, but it is in the community colleges. Comments included:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the community college programs and the EAST program already are stigmatized.
