- <u>SUBJECT</u>: DENTAL SCREENING (AT INTAKE)
- <u>POLICY</u>: Dental screening will be completed on each new inmate within seven (7) days of admission to a DOC facility. A dentist, dental assistant or nurse, may accomplish this screening.
- <u>REFERENCE</u>: NCCHC Standard P-E-06, Oral Care

PROCEDURE:

- A. The Dental Screening will include:
 - 1. Visual observation of the teeth and gums by a qualified health care provider.
 - 2. Notation of any obvious abnormalities.
 - 3. Dental referral if necessary.
 - 4. Documentation of the screening on the intake screening form.
 - 5. Scheduling with the dentist for a full examination when appropriate.
- B. If the inmate does not receive the dental screening at CCCF, it will be completed at the receiving institution.
