- Date:** Saturday, October 18<sup>th</sup> Linn Benton Community College, Albany, OR  
Sunday, October 19<sup>th</sup> 2008, Redmond High School, Redmond, OR
- Time:** 8:30am to 5:00pm both days
- Cost:** No entry fee required. Lunch and t-shirts will be provided free to participants.
- Guidelines:** Only one student from each ODOT-TSD provider location will be eligible to participate

**Application Deadline:** October 10, 2008

- Eligibility:** To participate in the Oregon Driver Excellence Scholarship Challenge, the student must:
1. be at least sixteen (16) but no more than twenty one (18) years of age;
  2. be enrolled in a recognized secondary (high) school;
  3. have an overall 3.0 (or equivalent) or better grade point average (from the last grading period);
  4. have completed an ODOT - TSD approved driver education program;
  5. have a drivers' license for a period of six months;
  6. have no record of traffic crashes;
  7. have no record of, or pending action on, traffic violations;
  8. have completed the required application;

**\*Note: Space is limited to 80 participants, selection for participation will be based on a first come, first served basis with one student from each location. Additional students may be considered if slots are available.**

- Activities:**
1. Knowledge/Written test
  2. Perception test
  3. Skill tests (2)
    - Parking maneuvers
    - Weaving - forward and backward
    - Steering in close limits
    - Front and rear limits - judgment of distance
    - Vehicle balance activities
  4. In-vehicle auto control simulation
