ENTER or SAY Current mailing zip code. **PRESS** To add a fraud alert to your credit report. or SAY PRESS To add an "Initial 90-Day" fraud or **SAY** alert to your credit report. 9-digit Social Security number. **ENTER or SAY** If this is correct, say YES or press [1] 6-digit Date of Birth followed by the ENTER or SAY (#) key. (For example: for May 4, 1933 enter 05-04-33.) 4-digit YEAR of birth followed by the **ENTER or SAY** #) key. Numeric address only followed by ENTER or SAY the # key. (For example: for 123 5th Avenue, enter ONLY the numbers 123.) 10-digit day time phone number. ENTER or SAY (The area code for Hawaii is 808.) If this is correct, say YES or press [1] 10-digit evening phone number. ENTER or SAY (The area code for Hawaii is 808.) If this is correct, say YES or press [1] Remain on the line to process your request.

Other Options:

PRESS To request a "7-year extended" fraud alert to the credit file.

PRESS To request a "1-year Active Duty" alert to the credit file.

If you successfully notify TransUnion, they will share your fraud alert request with the other national credit reporting agencies, Experian and Equifax. Fraud alerts will be automatically added to your credit reports with these reporting agencies. You will not need to contact these companies to request a fraud alert.
