Our mission is to ensure all employees have safe and equal access to electronic and information technology by assessing, educating, and advocating for the integration of assistive technology and worksite accommodations.

Assistive Technology (AT)

Demonstrate a wide range of AT products and work with our customers to determine the technology solution that best fits their needs and job functions through training and evaluation.

Ergonomics

Demonstrate a wide range of Ergo products and support our customers in their efforts to remain safe, comfortable, and injury free at their workstations through training, evaluation, and recommendation.

Education

Inform our customers on a variety of topics through events, trainings, and presentations. Topics include accessibility, ergonomics, disability awareness, AT, and emergency preparedness for people with disabilities.

Section 508

Provide customers with resources to support the development of accessible websites, electronic documents and programs.

Emergency Preparedness

Prepare persons with disabilities for emergency situations through education, planning, preparation, mitigation, and recovery.

Interpreting Services

Arrange for sign language interpreters, note-takers, and readers for USDA employees and events.



Temporary Disability

All USDA employees can take advantage of assistive technology (AT). The TARGET Center provides a local scooter loan program, as well as AT and Ergo equipment loans nationwide, as informal accommodations for USDA employees with temporary needs.

Alternative Formatting

Upon request, TARGET provides alternative (alt) formats of USDA publications and documents in Braille, large print, accessible PDF, and digital audio.

USDA/CAP Partnership

In 2001, USDA signed an interagency agreement with the Department of Defense/Computer/Electronic Accommodations Program so that AT may be provided at no cost to USDA agencies for USDA employees with a qualified disability.
