Oregon Commission on Historic Cemeteries **Historic Cemeteries Grants**

2007-2008 Grant Cycle

The Oregon Commission on Historic Cemeteries is pleased to announce the new round of Historic Cemeteries Grants. The funds allocated by the State through Heritage Programs of the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department will be available to support the preservation of cemeteries throughout Oregon.

OCHC grants are intended to provide financial assistance in the following general categories: Protection and Security, Restoration and Preservation, Education and Training, Research and Interpretation. Eligible projects may include, but aren't limited to: security fencing or lighting, skilled monument repair or training, conservation of historic elements such as fencing, curbs, markers, etc., documentation and mapping, signage, landscape restoration, planning and interpretation.

DEADLINE: Postmarked **September 15, 2007**. Funds available November 2007.

ELIGIBLITY

CEMETERIES: Any cemetery or burial site which contains burials of people who died on or prior to February 14, 1909, with visible above ground historic elements such as gravestones, markers, fencing, gates, or traditional and/or historic landscape materials such as shrubbery and trees, roadways and paths. Grant projects with an Oregon Statehood Sesquicentennial link or incorporating Sesquicentennial elements will also be considered. See www.oregon150.org for ideas and details about O-150 activities.

APPLICANTS: Individual citizens, organizations, schools, governments, and non-profit organizations may apply. However, if the applicant is not an auditable fund manager, the cooperation of a fund manager is needed. See next paragraph.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION: The OCHC grants program does not require a dollar match for funds requested, though we encourage you to seek local funding in addition to your grant request. Local financial support allows this OCHC grant program to assist more historic cemeteries across the state and fosters more local support for and interest in the care of the cemetery. Individual citizens and organizations receiving OCHC grant funds should keep clear records of all grant related funds and expenses in case of audit. Bids and estimates strengthen the grant request when projects require contracted work. Typical awards are in the range of \$1000-\$4000.

GRANT REPORTING AND PAYMENT: Awarded projects will be the subjects of binding agreements between the State and the applicants. Typically, the grant funds are dispersed on a reimbursable basis. If you are awarded a grant, details of payment arrangements and grant reporting will be provided at that time. Before and after photographs are required to report on the grant.
