John Maxon was appointed in 1849. It is unknown when he left the service.

William Chadwick a Gold Life Saving Medal Recipient was assigned on OCT 7, 1868 and resigned from service on MAY 21, 1887.

John W. Petit was appointed on MAY 18, 1887 and was discharge on SEP 10, 1904.

William A. Osborn was appointed on SEP 22, 1904 and was reassigned to Spring Lake Station on AUG 31, 1905.

William S. Simpson was appointed on AUG 25, 1905 and was still serving in 1915.

CBM L. G. Brower was in charge in 1929.
