Charles A. Holdskorn was appointed on NOV 22, 1893. It is unknown when he left the service.


William Holdskorn was appointed on NOV 23, 1883 and resigned due to physical reasons on JUL 26, 1900.

Lambert H. Parker was appointed on SEP 26, 1900 and resigned on MAR 4, 1903.

Frank Smith was appointed on FEB 27, 1903 and was still serving in 1915.
