



## Station Wallop's Beach, Virginia

Coast Guard Station #151

<b>Location:</b>	On Wallops Island, 4 3/4 miles west southwest of Assateague Light, and 1 3/8 miles southwest of Chincoteague Inlet; 37-52' 00"N x 75-56' 50"W
<b>Date of Conveyance</b>	1883
<b>Station Built:</b>	1883
<b>Fate:</b>	Discontinued in 1947

### Keepers:

John B. Whealton was appointed on MAR 13, 1884 and resigned due to physical reasons on OCT 12, 1911.

George F. Reynolds was appointed on OCT 3, 1911 and was still serving in 1915.

### Remarks:

Station was acquired by the Navy Department as a firing range.
