

## **Local Office Data – Third Quarter 2003**

### **Description**

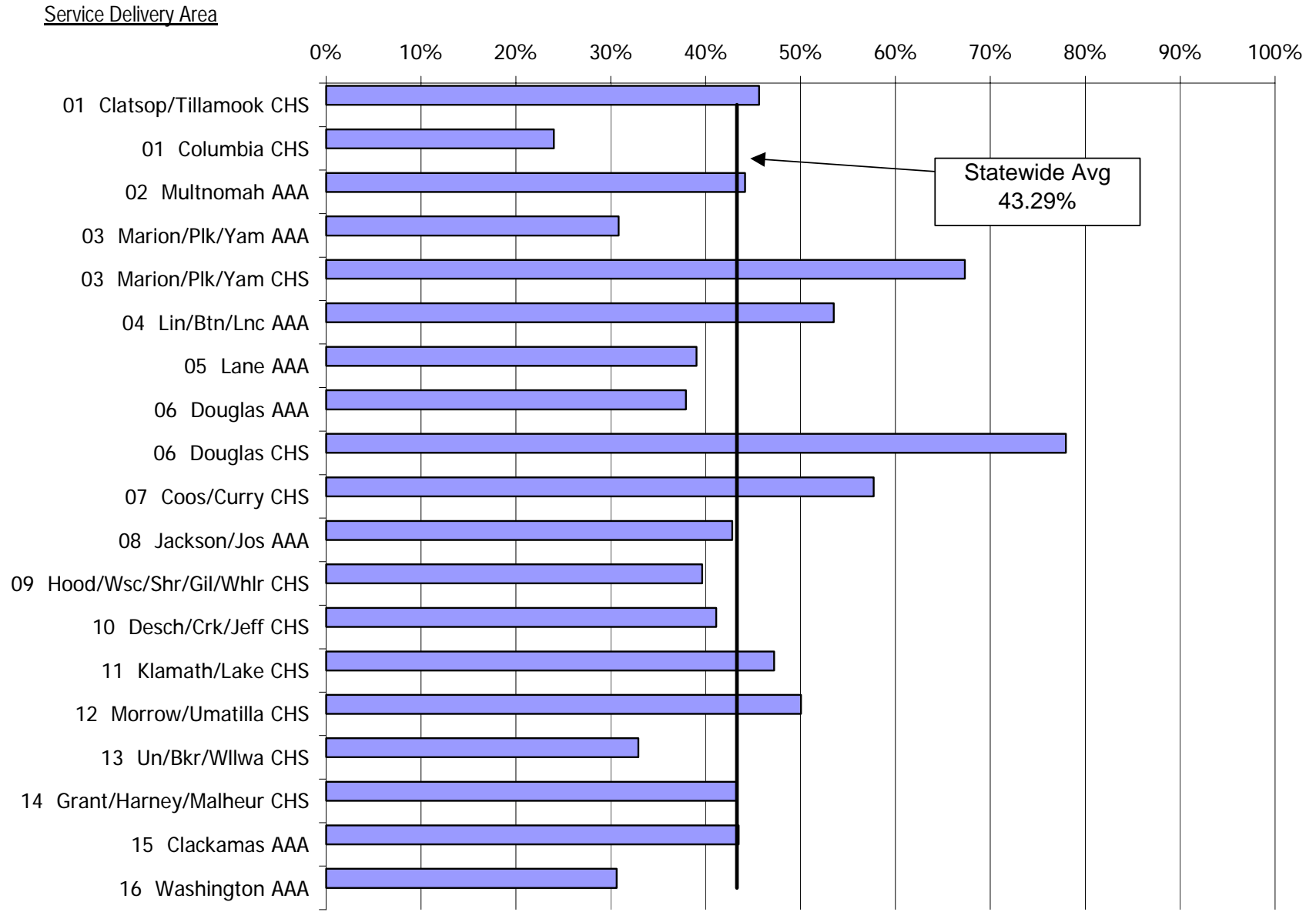

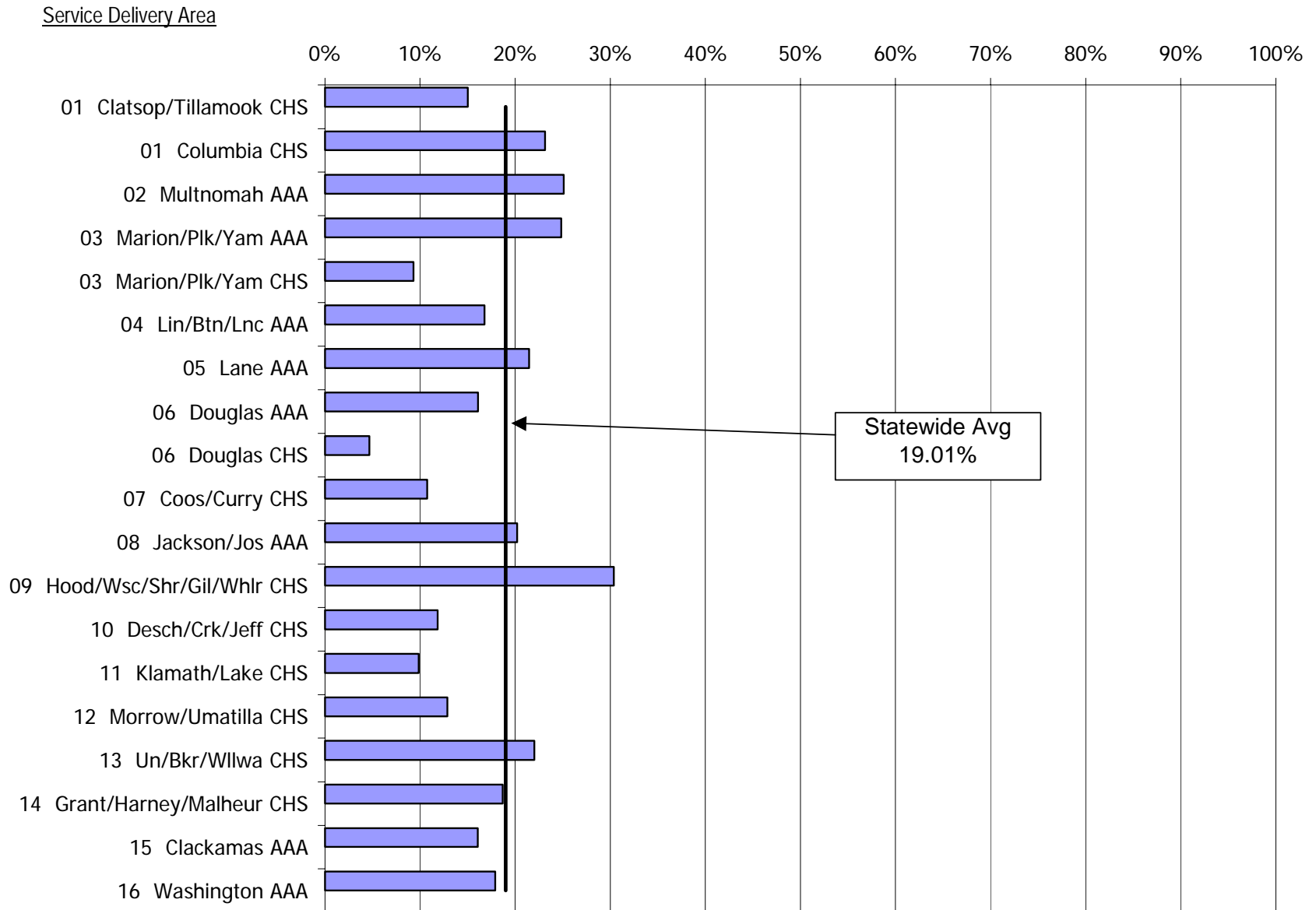

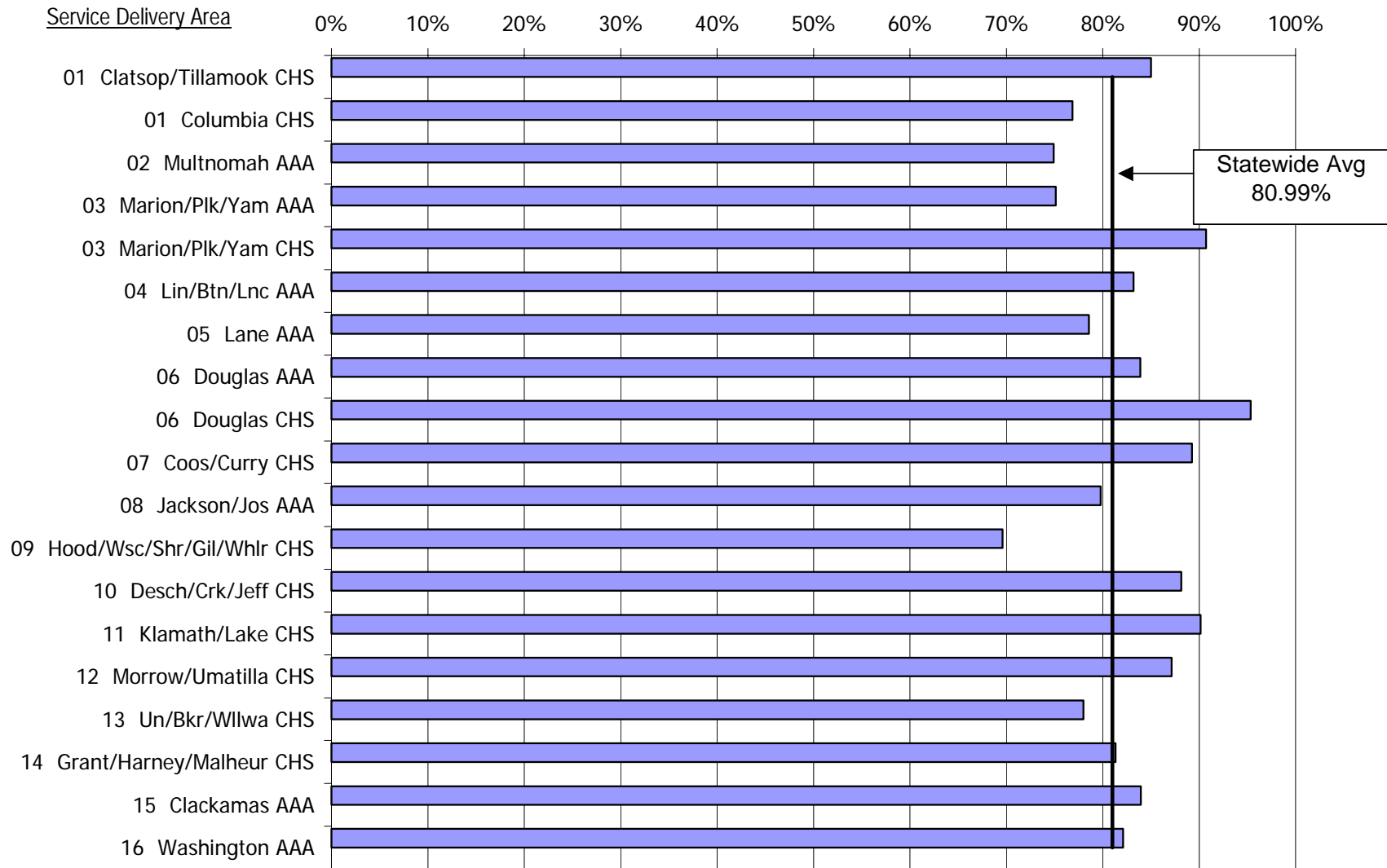

## Percent Served In Community Based Care - September, 2003



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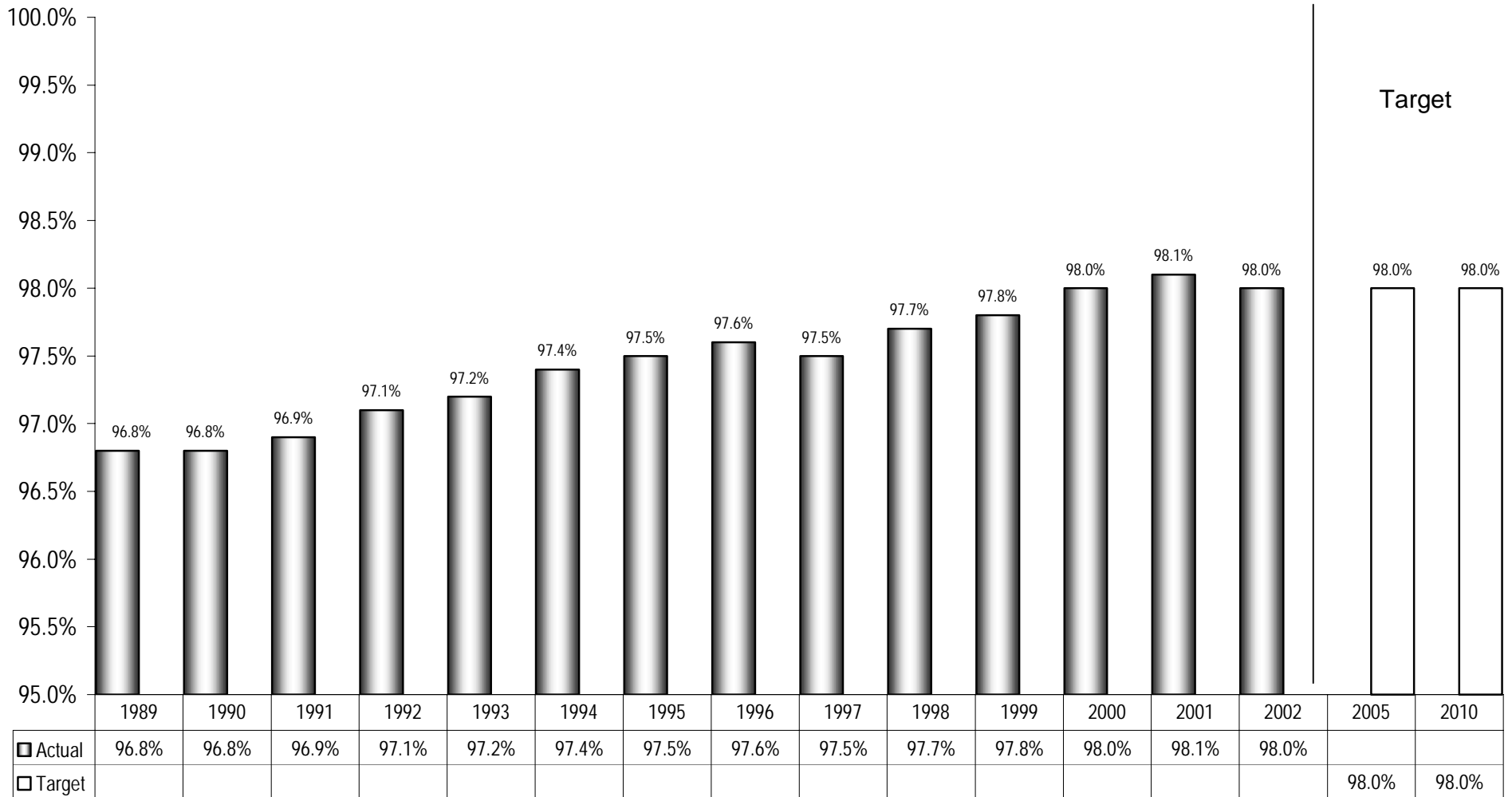

## Percent of Seniors over 65 Living independently (Oregon benchmark 58)



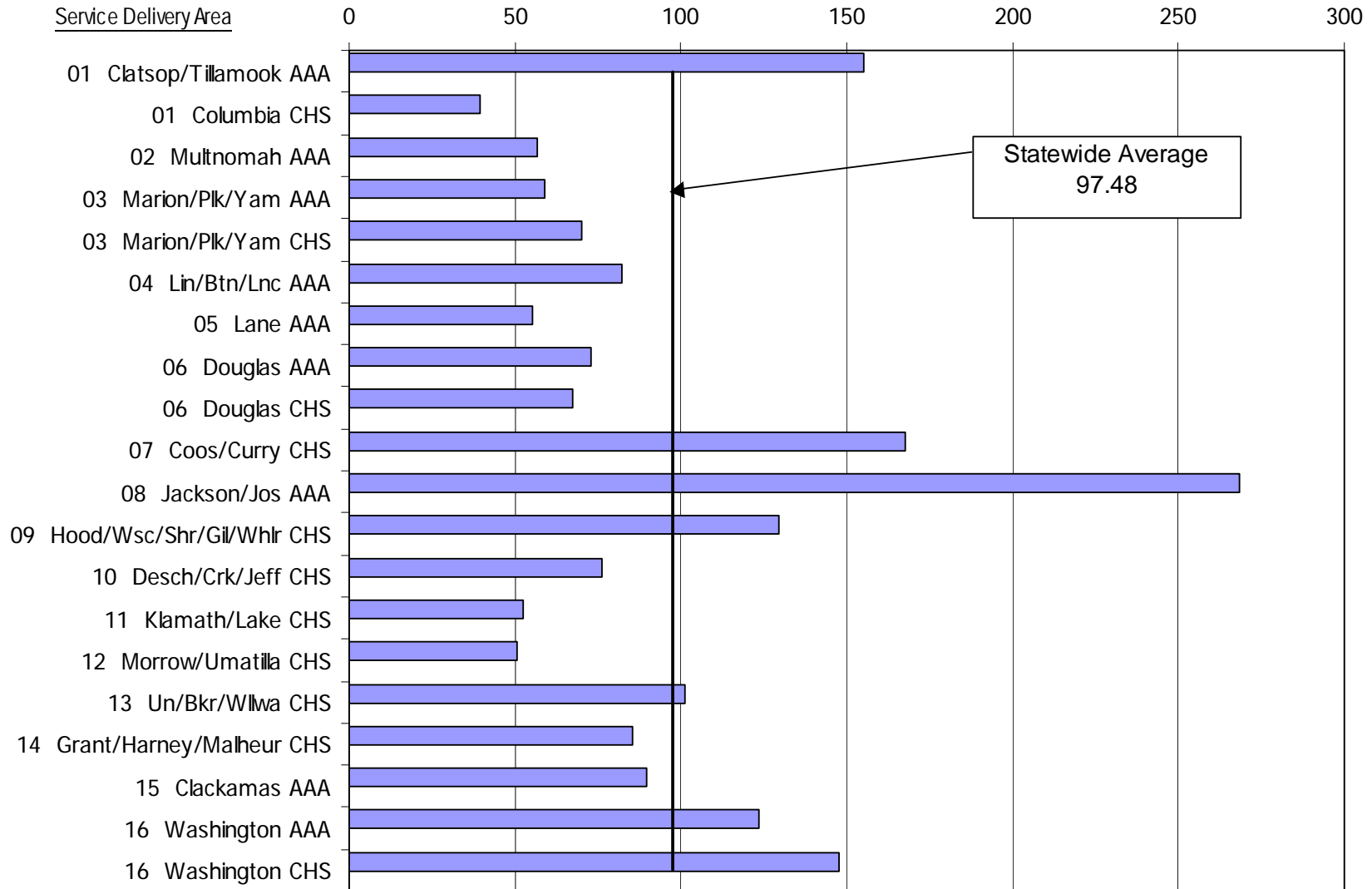
