

Long Term Objectives: 2007 - 2012

Objective #1:

By December 2012, increase 4:3:1:3:3:1 immunization coverage rates for 2-year-olds by five percentage points, from 71.8% to 76.8%.

(Source: ALERT and PBR Project; Baseline = 71.8%, CY 2005).

Objective # 2:

By December 2012, for infants perinatally exposed to hepatitis B, increase completion rate for three doses of hepatitis B vaccine by 8 months of age from 71% to 76% and increase the rate of post-vaccination serology testing from 59% to 64%.

(Source: Oregon Perinatal Hepatitis B Case Management Program; Baseline = 71% and 59%, CY 2005).

Objective #3:

By December 2012, increase annual influenza immunization rate among health care workers by eight percentage points from 45.8% to 53.8%.

(Source: Oregon BRFSS; Baseline = 45.8%, CY 2005).

Objective #4

By December 2012, implement and maintain a single Immunization Information System (IIS) for public and private providers.

(Baseline = Oregon has two IISs: ALERT and IRIS, CY 2005)

Objective #5

By December 2012, coverage levels for female 11-12 year olds will be 40% for one or more doses of HPV3.

(Source: ALERT; Baseline = 0%, CY2005)

Objective #6

By December 2012, coverage levels for seventh graders will be 90% for Tdap1.

(Source: Certification of Immunization Status; Baseline = 0%, CY2005)
