Training Topics:

- DMV – summary of information, charges, person, licenses, no dispositions with CCH's or control numbers to link back to misdemeanors-only show when it's a felony
NOTE: want DMV photos
- Reinforcing CCH's, what can and can't be released, understanding results—Nationwide searches
- NCO feature
- Security of system, understanding
- Immigration information – clarify what it's about
- CCH – understanding between LEDS & OJIN in regards to dispositions or lack of – Judgments
- Wants & warrants for juveniles – what information is needed

Delivery:

- In person training annually by region

Frequency:

Every six months to start then go to annual

Requirements:

- No requirement, rather have annual recertification with signed consent

2009 Recertification Topics Classification Specific:

- Security
- Summary of OAR
- For inquiry only, training is not necessary for recertification
- What information can be released
- When can you run information
- Running Vehicles
- Examples of acceptable use of LEDS re: courts
- CCH justification-describe what they can run CCH's for, addresses etc.
- Electronic testing/signature in future

Note:

If you have staff that have been called to active duty, make training record inactive using code MIL. Also, if you have staff who are out on short, long term disability or administrative leave, make their training records inactive. They can recertify when they return.

2011 Recertification:

- Bi-annual recertification with test (no test for inquiry)
- Signed consent-yes
