

A view of the National Heritage Areas in 2003

Visitation and Volunteerism

31,672,236 people visited heritage areas, and volunteers worked 167,314 hours in heritage areas.

Partnerships

Heritage areas have formalized relationships with 996 partners, and 2,480 informal relationships with partners.

Education

Heritage areas and their partners managed 513 educational programs, and 740,775 people participated in educational programs.

National Register of Historic Places

Heritage areas awarded 117 grants to National Register/ eligible structures, contributed to 172 enhancements projects, and include
244 new listings on the National Register of Historic Places.

Grants

Heritage areas awarded 367 grants, which leveraged

\$29,276,585 in additional funds.

Trails projects

Heritage areas awarded 67 grants for recreation trails,

that assisted the creation and enhancement of 97 new trails projects.

Leveraging Federal funding

Funding by NPS Heritage Partnerships Program leveraged *\$60 million* in Federal, state, local, and private dollars, a ratio of *1:5*.
