Visitation and Volunteerism

31,672,236 people visited heritage areas, and
volunteers worked **167,314** hours in heritage areas.

Partnerships

Heritage areas have formalized relationships with **996** partners, and
2,480 informal relationships with partners.

Education

Heritage areas and their partners managed **513** educational programs, and
740,775 people participated in educational programs.

National Register of Historic Places

Heritage areas awarded **117** grants to National Register/ eligible structures,
contributed to **172** enhancements projects, and include
244 new listings on the National Register of Historic Places.

Grants

Heritage areas awarded **367** grants, which leveraged
\$29,276,585 in additional funds.

Trails projects

Heritage areas awarded **67** grants for recreation trails,
that assisted the creation and enhancement of **97** new trails projects.

Leveraging Federal funding

Funding by NPS Heritage Partnerships Program leveraged **\$60 million**
in Federal, state, local, and private dollars, a ratio of **1:5**.
