



## Tips to Expedite the MBE/WBE Certification Process

At OMWESB, we receive an average of 350 new applications a year. All applications are processed on a “first-come, first-served” basis. However, there are several things you can do to make the certification process go smoothly. Here are our top tips:

1. Know which type of certification you are applying for:
  - **Minority Business Enterprise (MBE)** — This program is regulated by *state* eligibility requirements and applies to ethnic minority-owned businesses (owned by males or females) that seek contracting opportunities with city, county, state, and private industry in Oregon.
  - **Women Business Enterprise (WBE)** — This program is regulated by *state* eligibility requirements and applies to businesses owned by women who wish to seek contracting opportunities with city, county, state, and private industry in Oregon.
2. If your business is not for-profit, then you do not qualify for this program and should not submit an application.
3. Fill out the entire application and send all requested documentation. **Incomplete applications will be returned.**
4. Apply only for certification in areas in which you (minority or women), have expertise. List the corresponding North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) codes that apply. For example, if a business is seeking certification in mechanical engineering, the minority or women owners must have this expertise.
5. Ensure that your licenses are current in Oregon.
6. When a certification specialist calls to schedule a telephone interview, make yourself available at your earliest convenience.
7. If a certification specialist requests additional information, fax, e-mail, or mail it before the deadline.
8. If you know you are going to bid on a particular project, apply well in advance.
9. Make sure your application is signed by the minority or women owner and notarized.

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## **Minority/Women Business Enterprise (MBE/WBE) Certification Requirements**

The Oregon Department of Consumer & Business Services Office of Minority, Women & Emerging Small Business (OMWESB) is responsible for the certification of all Minority (MBE) and Women Business Enterprises (WBE) in Oregon. State law (ORS 200) authorizes this program.

To be certified, you must complete and return the enclosed application form and the required documentation specific to your legal structure. Your application will be assigned and reviewed according to the date it was received. A certification specialist will contact you to schedule an interview.

If your business is certified, you will receive a letter of confirmation. We require recertification every three years after the initial certification. Once certified, your business will appear in our online directory of certified businesses.

### **To qualify as a MBE or WBE, all of the following criteria must be met:**

- The business must be at least 51 percent owned by one or more ethnic minorities or women.
- The minority or women business owners must have managerial and operational control over all aspects of the business, as defined by OAS 445-050-0030(9)a-k (included on Page 4 of this packet).
- The minority or women owners must have made a contribution of capital and expertise to the business commensurate with their ownership interest.
- This must be a small business whose average annual gross receipts for the previous three fiscal tax years (for itself and its affiliates) do not exceed the size standards as set by the North American Industrial Classification System (NAICS) and the amounts shown for the following categories:
  - General contractor ..... \$28,500,000
  - Specialty contractor ..... \$13,000,000
  - Engineering and surveying businesses ..... \$4,500,000
  - Non-construction businesses..... according to NAICS standards  
(Size standards subject to change.)
- To qualify, the majority owner or owners must be citizens of the United States or lawfully admitted permanent residents and must meet criteria below:

Any individual in the following groups, members of which are rebuttably presumed to be socially and economically disadvantaged:

- (i) “Black Americans,” which includes persons having origins in any of the Black racial groups of Africa
- (ii) “Hispanic Americans,” which includes persons of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Dominican, Central or South American, or other Spanish or Portuguese culture or origin, regardless of race
- (iii) “Native Americans,” which includes persons who are American Indians, Eskimos, Aleuts, or Native Hawaiians
- (iv) “Asian-Pacific Americans,” which includes persons with origins in Japan, China, Taiwan, Korea, Burma (Myanmar), Vietnam, Laos, Cambodia (Kampuchea), Thailand, Malaysia, Indonesia, the Philippines, Brunei, Samoa, Guam, the U.S. Trust Territories of the Pacific Islands (Republic of Palau), the Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas Islands, Macao, Fiji, Tonga, Kiribati, Tuvalu, Nauru, Federated States of Micronesia, or Hong Kong
- (v) “Subcontinent Asian Americans,” which includes persons with origins in India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, the Maldives Islands, Nepal, or Sri Lanka

- (vi) Women, regardless of ethnicity or
- (vii) Any additional groups whose members are designated as socially and economically disadvantaged by the Small Business Administration (SBA), at such time as the SBA designation becomes effective
- (viii) Any individual on a case-by-case basis

STOP! If your business does not meet the certification requirements then you do not qualify for this program and do NOT need to fill out this application.

**Eligibility Standards for Minority and Women Business Enterprise (MBE/WBE)**

To be eligible as a Minority or Women Business Enterprise, a business must meet the following criteria. The OMWESB may perform on-site investigations to verify any of the requirements of this rule.

- (1) The business must be a Small Business. The average annual gross receipts for a business and its affiliates for the previous three fiscal years must not exceed the amounts established under SBA's NAICS codes.
- (2) The business must be Controlled by one or more Qualifying Individual(s).
  - (a) The Qualifying Individual(s) must establish Minority Group or gender status by identification, US citizenship, birth certificate, driver's license, state identification cards, naturalization documents, military discharge papers, visa, passport, etc., or evaluation for social and economic disadvantage.
- (3) The business must be Owned by one or more Minority or women owners.
- (4) The one or more Qualifying Individual(s) must have made a contribution of assets to the business .
- (5) The business must be Independent.
- (6) The business must be in existence, operational and in business for profit.
- (7) The business must be properly licensed, and if required, legally registered in the state.
- (8) The business must have or lease (where leasing is a normal industry practice and the lease does not involve a relationship with a prime contractor or other party that compromises the independence of the business) sufficient machinery, equipment and employees to operate. In making this determination the OMWESB shall compare the operations of the MBE/WBE to a non-MBE/WBE operation in the same or similar business.
- (9) The Qualifying Individual(s) must have training and experience in the field(s) of operation for which certification is sought. Examples of construction related activities, including but not limited to:
  - (a) Currently holds or has previously held the essential license in the field in which this business operates;
  - (b) Has read and interpreted blueprints and specifications;
  - (c) Has done take offs;
  - (d) Has prepared estimates and bids;
  - (e) Goes on site and determines if the work is proceeding in accordance with the plans;
  - (f) Answers technical questions from subordinates;
  - (g) Resolves field problems;
  - (h) Supervises field operations.; Examples of professional related activities, including but not limited to;
  - (i) Has a college degree in the field of expertise;
  - (j) Has years of experience and training in the field of expertise;
  - (k) Has experience in project management in the field of expertise.
