Enter your LDAP user name and password to access the on-line Ergonomic Evaluation Request page. Once you've created an electronic record for yourself, EH&S will assign an evaluator to contact you to schedule an appointment to complete the ergonomic evaluation.

Purpose: To perform an ergonomic evaluation of employee's computer workstation to assure configuration and work practices do not pose ergonomic risks/hazards.

Objectives:

- Onsite personal evaluation of computer users (>4 hours).
- To identify and correct/eliminate at risk ergonomic hazards and work practices.

Evaluators: Jeffrey Chung or designated trained Ergonomic Evaluator
