Course Purpose: EHS-802 is designed for Lab employees designated by their lab management as the Division Occurrence Reporting and Processing System (ORPS) Points-of-Contact. Other employees who serve as EH&S staff, EH&S Division Liaisons, Division safety managers, and Division Safety Coordinators may need this course. Training course offers familiarization with DOE Order 231.1A & DOE Manual 231.1-2, and the Lab's site-specific ORPS procedures manual, LBID-2488. Training orients attendees to recognize their reporting responsibilities to DOE for events outlined in the manual.

Course Objectives:

- To provide detailed policies, procedures and information found in DOE Order 231.1; Environment, Safety, and Health Reporting, DOE Manual 231.1-2; Occurrence Reporting and Processing of Operations Information, and the Berkeley Lab's site-specific manual, LBID-2488; Occurrence Reporting and Processing System (ORPS).
- To present and interpret reportable criteria and site-specific examples of events deemed worthy of reporting to DOE through ORPS.
- To familiarize Division ORPS points of contact and other staff with safety responsibilities with DOE's ORPS notification requirements, to include event identification, phoned and written notification reports, investigations, updates, final reports, and report closure responsibilities.
