

Highways Classified as Expressways
1999 Oregon Highway Plan
Amendment 01-05
April 11, 2001

The Oregon Transportation Commission amended the 1999 Oregon Highway Plan on April 11, 2001 at the Commission meeting in Salem to make the technical corrections to the milepoints or descriptions of the Expressways listed in the following tables.

Expressways are a subset of Highway Plan highway classifications to provide for high speed, high volume travel between cities and connections to ports and major recreation areas with minimal interruptions. A secondary function is to provide for long distance intra-urban travel in metropolitan areas. In urban areas, speeds are moderate to high. In rural areas, speeds are high.

The Commission originally classified these Expressways on May 11, 2000 and June 7, 2000. See Amendments 00-02 and 00-03.

The list of Expressways in the Expressway file includes the technical corrections and should be used for approach road permits.
