## 6. Agreement and Signature

Requirements of a Tax-Credit Certified Technician include the following. There may be other requirements.

A Tax-Credit Certified Technician must:

- 1. Assure the system is of the high quality, performance and durability.
- 2. Assure the system owners have received a one-year full written warranty for the system that lasts no less than 12 months after the system is installed.
- 3. Complete requirements specified for the technology and participate in annual update telephone conference call.
- 4. Deal with both the Oregon Department of Energy staff and Oregon consumers in good faith with the highest professional conduct and adhere to tax credit program rules.
- 5. Assure that all installations are done in accordance with local building codes and have been properly permitted.
- 6. Provide the owner with a user manual.
- 7. Explain proper operation and maintenance of the system to the owner.
- 8. Complete the technical information on the tax credit application, sign the tax credit application to verify installation and present the tax credit application to the owner to submit to the Oregon Department of Energy.
- 9. Explain the tax credit application process and pass-through option to the owner.
- 10. Not make false claims regarding Oregon Department of Energy tax-credit certification.

By signing below I agree to adhere the most current rules governing Oregon's Residential Energy Tax Credit Program (OAR 330-070), and additional requirements listed above. I understand that failure to meet these requirements is grounds for revocation of this certification by the Oregon Department of Energy. I certify that the information provided is complete and accurate.
