Background:

After a year and a half of research, deliberation, public meetings and draft documents, the Centennial Horizon publication is presented for approval. Input from commissioners has been synthesized into a final document. Substantive changes to the document since the July 2008 prototype include:

- Reordered action items to better reflect the relative significance of the actions;
- Reworked Principle 3 to strengthen it as a Primary Principle;
- Reworked Principle 5 Strategies and Actions to better reflect the description and vision for the principle; and
- Changed introductory letter to describe the plan as a living document with two-year review processes.

In addition, we made minor grammatical and clarifying edits where needed.

The final prototypes will be distributed to commissioners prior to this meeting. Upon approval, the document will be bound, printed, distributed to staff and made available for interested public and stakeholders. In addition, the document will be available in electronic form on the ORPD website.

Staff will present the action plan for the two-year update cycle at a winter, 2009, commission meeting.
