STATE ID CARDS AT LANAI COMMUNITY CENTER

HONOLULU, HAWAII – Attorney General Mark Bennett announced today that State ID personnel will be at the Lanai Community Center to process applications for State ID cards on Saturday, May 21, 2005, from 8:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Information on application requirements is available at (808) 587-3111 (recorded message) or www.hawaii.gov/hcjd.

Priority will be given to individuals with completed applications and required certified documents. Applicants may obtain application forms on-site.

The fee is \$10 for senior citizens 65 years and older, and \$15 for all others, payable in cash only. State ID cards will be processed and mailed back to applicants within ten working days.
