State ID Cards at Filipino Community Center

(HONOLULU) State ID personnel will be at the Filipino Community Center in Waipahu to process applications for State ID cards on Saturday, July 16, 2005, from 8:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The center is located at 94-428 Mokuola Street.

Applicants may obtain application forms on-site. The fee is \$10 for senior citizens 65 years and older, and \$15 for all others, payable in cash only. Priority will be given to applicants with completed application forms and required certified documents. State ID cards will be processed and mailed back to applicants within ten working days.
