STATE ID CARDS AT KAISER HIGH SCHOOL

(HONOLULU) State ID personnel will be at Kaiser High School, 511 Lunalilo Home Road, to process applications for State ID cards on Saturday, October 29, 2005, from 8:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The fee is \$10.00 for senior citizens 65 years and older, and \$15.00 for all others, payable in cash only.

Priority will be given to applicants with completed application forms and required <u>certified</u> documents. Applications without these documents cannot be processed.

- New applicants must provide an original social security card and a <u>certified</u> copy of their birth certificate (or resident alien card, if applicable).
- For renewals of current ID cards with no change in name or citizenship, no other documents are required.
- Changes in name or citizenship due to marriage, divorce, annulment, adoption, or naturalization must be supported by <u>certified</u> copies of government-issued documents. Altered or illegible documents are not acceptable.

State ID cards will be processed and mailed to applicants within ten business days.
