FREE CHILD IDENTIFICATION KITS TO BE PROVIDED THIS WEEKEND AT WALMART IN MILILANI

Honolulu, Hawaii - Parents are encouraged to bring their children to the Mililani Wal-Mart on Saturday, October 18th, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., for KidCare IDs. The KidCare booklets will include descriptive information, fingerprints and a current photo for each child.

Polaroid and the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children developed Project KidCare to raise awareness of child safety and provide parents with an effective tool to aid law enforcement in the search of a missing child.

The Missing Child Center-Hawaii, Mutual of Omaha and Wal-Mart Mililani have joined together to provide this free service to the community. The Honolulu Police Department and the Department of Public Safety will be helping with fingerprints, photographs and information. Mililani High School's LEO and KEY Clubs; sisters Alicia and Justine Michioka, Miss Hawaii USAs of 2003 and 2004; Camille Perao, Miss Hawaii Teen USA 2003; Olena Rubin, Miss Garden Isle 2003; and Lyanna Tumeneng, Miss Oahu 2003, will be distributing child safety information and assisting parents and children in completing the booklets.
