## STATE ID CARDS AT WAIPAHU HIGH SCHOOL AND FUTURE ID CARD EVENTS

(HONOLULU) State ID personnel will be available to process applications for State ID cards at Waipahu High School at 94-1211 Farrington Highway in the school cafeteria, on Saturday, June 16, 2007 from 8:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The fee is \$10.00 for senior citizens 65 years and older, and \$15.00 for all others, payable in cash only.

Priority will be given to applicants with completed application forms and required <u>certified</u> documents. Applications without these documents cannot be processed.

- New applicants must <u>minimally</u> provide an original social security card, and a certified copy of their birth certificate or a resident alien card, if applicable;
- For renewals of current ID cards with NO change in name <u>and</u> citizenship, no other documents are required;
- All changes in status or name due to marriage, divorce, annulment, adoption or citizenship must also be supported by legal, certified documents. Copied, altered or illegible documents are not acceptable.

Further questions can be directed to (808) 587-3112. Application forms can be downloaded from the website and will also be available at their office. Maps are also provided on the website.

State ID cards will be processed and mailed back to the applicant within 5-10 working days.
