**ATTORNEY GENERAL CHARGES EIGHT IN IOLANI PALACE INCIDENT**

HONOLULU – The Department of the Attorney General has charged seven individuals with Burglary in the Second Degree for allegedly entering Iolani Palace unlawfully on August 15, 2008 with the intent to commit a crime against property rights. The seven are James Akahi, also known as Akahi Nui; Grace Akahi, also known as Akahi Wahine; Wayne Nunes; Waynette Nunes; Terry N. Kaahanui; Tanya K. Kaahanui; and Vanessa Fimbres.

The seven were charged by way of an information complaint. Their initial appearance in the Circuit Court is scheduled for October 2, 2008, except for James Akahi, who is scheduled for his initial appearance on October 6, 2008.

An eighth individual, Donald Alfred Love-Boltz, has been charged with Assault in the Second Degree for allegedly assaulting Betty Jean Noelani Ah Yuen, Facilities Manager for the Friends of Iolani Palace, on August 15, 2008. Love-Boltz's case is set for trial in the week of November 10, 2008.

Burglary in the Second Degree and Assault in the Second Degree are class C felonies punishable by up to five years imprisonment and a \$10,000 fine.

A criminal charge is only an accusation. The eight individuals named above are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.


THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

On or about the 15<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2008, in the City and  
County of Honolulu, State of Hawaii, GRACE AKAHI, also known as  
AKAHI WAHINE, JAMES AKAHI, also know as AKAHI NUI, VANESSA  
FIMBRES, TANYA KAAHANUI, TERRY KAAHANUI, WAYNE NUNES, and  
WAYNETTE NUNES, also known as RAYNETTE NUNES, did intentionally

enter or remain unlawfully in a building, to wit, Iolani Palace,  
with intent to commit therein a crime against a person or  
against property rights, thereby committing the offense of  
Burglary in the Second Degree in violation of Section 708-811 of  
the Hawaii Revised Statutes.
