PURPOSE: To transmit to the Office of Apprenticeship Training, Employer & Labor Services (OATELS), Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training (BAT) Staff the revised National Guideline Standards for SimplexGrinnell.

BACKGROUND: These revised National Guideline Standards for SimplexGrinnell were certified by the OATELS Administrator on December 8, 2004. They are a model for developing local apprenticeship programs registered with the BAT or State Apprenticeship Agency/Councils for the Sprinkler Fitter and the Protective Signal Installer (Fire Alarm and Security Technician) occupations.

There should be very little deviation from the Apprenticeship Standards (except for wages and the journeyworker rate) when they are developed locally by BAT Staff.

An electronic copy of the revised National Guideline Standards is attached for your information and use.

ACTION: OATELS/BAT staff should familiarize themselves with these revised National Guideline Standards.
