Since the Star Bulletin put out an editorial that HIOSH is taking money away from the students, Director Ching requested members' assistance in getting the word out that that was not HIOSH's intent. DOE's final penalty of \$57,000 was reduced to \$30,000 for improving above and beyond certain safety issues. 	
Crane Operator Certification	 Question was asked what requirements are there for rental companies to ensure that the operator or renter is capable of operating the equipment safely. HIOSH does not address that. A working draft of enforcing instructions for HIOSH's inspectors was distributed. Within the next couple weeks, HIOSH intends to send a letter with the finalized instructions to those affected. Suggestion was made to notify the public by issuing a press release, putting the announcement on HIOSH's website, and sending letters to contract associations.
