What I would like to add is that a statement needs to be added by the provider describing the exact services that are provided in return for the fees. I find that many consumers are under the assumption that they are receiving services that they in fact do not receive. Frequently I hear that 401(k) investors are under the impression that their accounts are being “managed” by their provider, when in fact, no management advice is being given. This leads to a false sense of security among many investors.
