

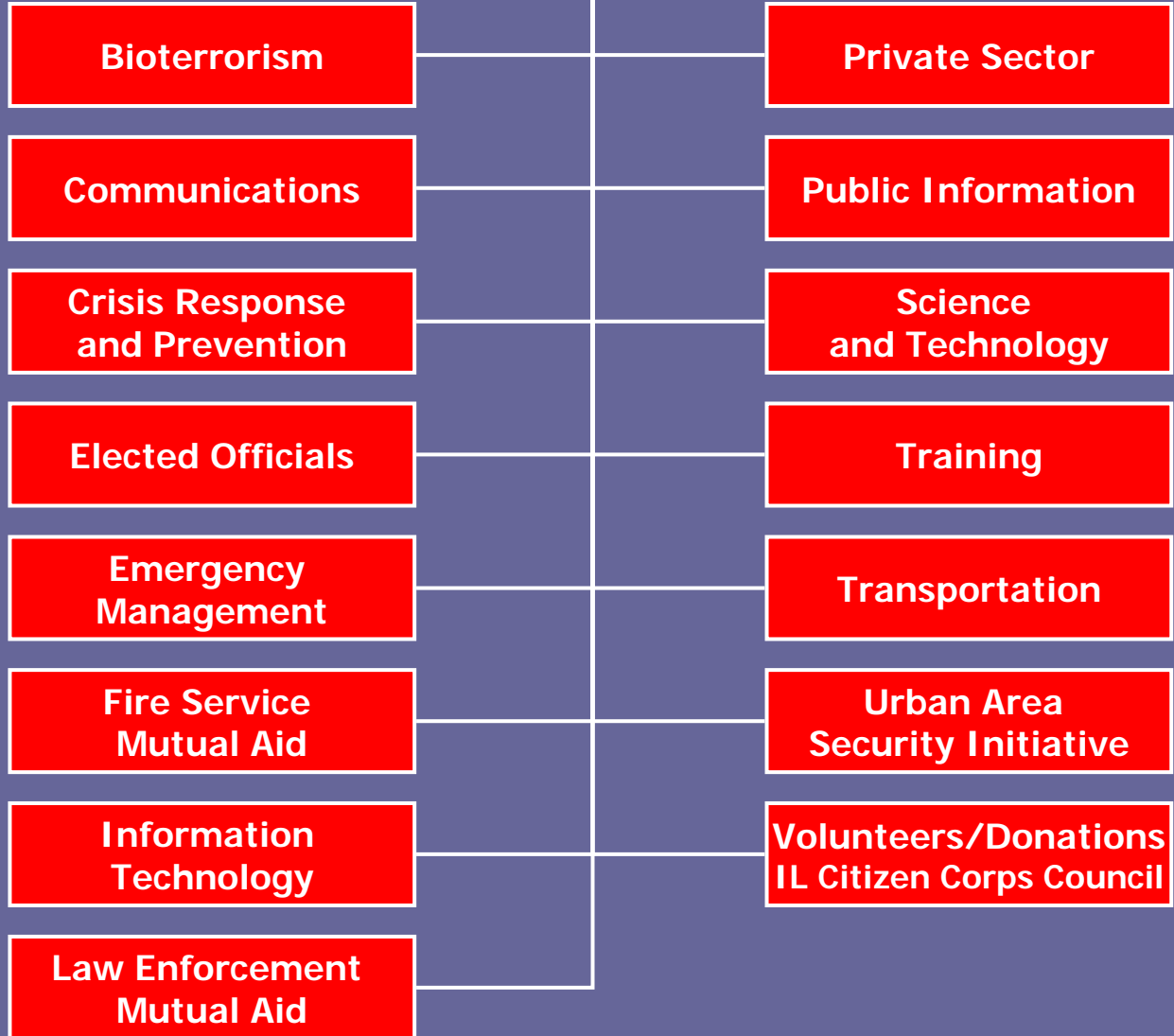
Illinois Citizen Corps Program



Illinois Terrorism Task Force

- Illinois Terrorism Task Force (ITTF) was created in 1999 by a Governor's Executive Order and has over 70 members.
- ITTF is the senior policy committee regarding all Homeland Security Grants in the State of Illinois.
- The Illinois Citizen Corps Council is a standing committee of the Illinois Terrorism Task Force (ITTF).

Illinois SAA

- The Illinois SAA is the Illinois Emergency Management Agency.
- The Illinois Terrorism Task Force is managed within IEMA by various staff.
- This link is the tie that binds all programs.
- We do grants and programs together in one place!

Illinois Citizen Corps Program

- Any Citizen Corps funding as well as any funding related to preparedness is vetted through the Illinois Council for full recommendation to the ITTF.
- Illinois Citizen Corps is managed not only programmatically but administratively with grants through one shop (key to success in Illinois!).
- After approval, ITTF staff work with the 98 local Councils on not just grants but programs.

Illinois Citizen Corps Program

- The one stop shop for homeland security including Citizen Corps allows us to be effective.
- Effectiveness includes taking any ideas from other areas and any funding as well!

Funding Examples

- Utilized \$205,000 from 2003 Part II State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP) to give grants to local Citizen Corps Councils for printing brochures.
- Utilized \$100,000 from September 11th license plate fees to give grants to local Citizen Corps Councils.
- 2004 Second Chance Grant-reobligated \$286,000 of unspent Citizen Corps funds to new proposals.
