

The highest number of fatal work injuries occurred in the private construction sector, followed by transportation and warehousing.

Agriculture, forestry, fishing, and hunting had a fatality rate more than 8 times the rate of 4.0 recorded for all workers, while mining had more than 6 times the all-

worker rate.
