

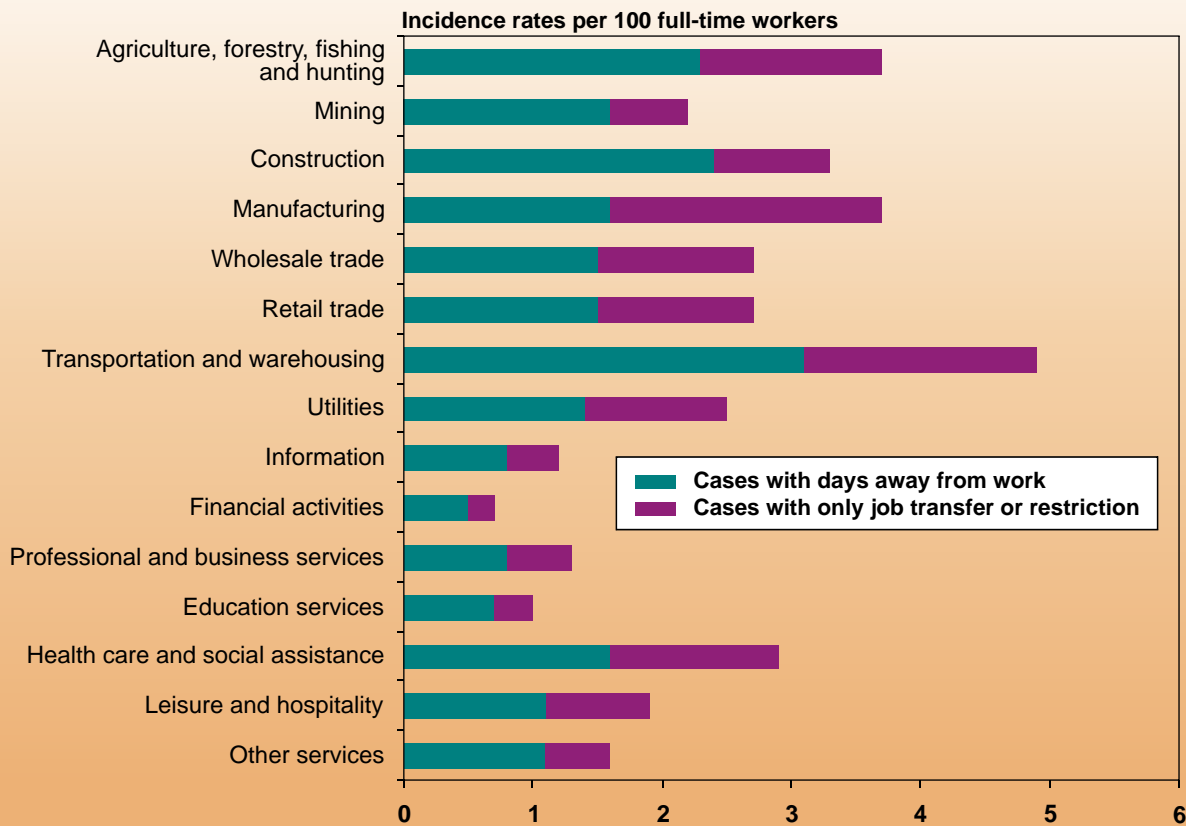
Transportation and warehousing accounted for the highest incidence rate for days away from work, job transfer, or restriction, with 4.9 cases per 100 full-time workers.

The total rate for cases with days away from work, job transfer, or restriction was 2.5 cases per 100 full-time workers.

The rate for cases with days away from work was 1.4 cases per 100 full-time workers, and the rate for cases with only job transfer, or restriction was 1.1 cases per 100 full-time workers.
